If new requirements are introduced by the agency under policy and procedures for issuance of night noise, is the task force need to review and/or approval the adoption of these set procedures? Or does the DPH determine or review the process of agency application process?

- a. What information is need for the task force to gather from DPW to make its three year assessment to the board? Will a list of equipments used by the specific companies with a range of sound level or will daily report of sound levels for that specific permit be need to task force review?
- b. Will the Public need to be notified if there is an issuance for a night noise permit by the particular agency? And how far in advance is the public notification necessary?
- c. What happens if there is a complaint? Is agency or DPH contacted for agency permit? Is enforcement left up to the agency or DPH along with the Police Department? How will they [DPH or Police Department] be notified of the issuance of agency night noise permit?
- d. If DPH goes to the site, does DPH need be reimbursed for cost recovery before or after the issuance of the permit?

- e. Who can do the noise level test or submit a report? Can applicant submit a test report? And are these reports to be submitted to DPH or Police Department?
- f. Does DPH need to have a certified noise level test reports?
- g. If DPT does not waiver for day time operations, should not the residents be notified seven days prior of the night time work in a residential neighborhood?
