**Brief Program Description:** The CHDP/EPSTDT Unit carries out the administrative & operational components of the CHDP/EPSTDT program required by State & Federal mandates. The unit has oversight & implementation responsibility for program guidelines with health providers, community agencies & managed care plans. The program provides outreach, community education & information, provider training & monitoring of well child physical exams, case management & referral for follow-up & treatment of diagnosed conditions for children < 21. CHDP funds periodic preventive health assessments, immunizations, vision/hearing, lead tests, lab tests, health education & anticipatory guidance. CHDP programs are located in every health department in CA and CHDP providers are found throughout CA.
