ADOPTED AND APPROVED MEETING MINUTES December 18, 2000

I. Introductions, Roll Call, and Approval of Minutes

The Chair, Mr. Frederick Hobson, called the meeting to order at 12:30p. Introductions were made. No quorum was established; therefore the meeting minutes from November were not approved.

II. Rational Drug Policies in San Francisco Public Symposium

Mr. Frederick Hobson attended the public symposium on Rational Drug Policies in San Francisco: Post Proposition 36 on November 29th. Mr. Hobson stated that the symposium started later than its scheduled time and that it was quite informative. Ms. Mathis received a copy of the documents that were passed out at the symposium.

Mr. Hobson added that the “new” Board of Supervisors is scheduled to be sworn in to office in early January 2001. Mr. Vernon Grigg commented that the public symposium was a “positive” start for the implementation of Proposition 36 from District Attorney Terence Hallinan.

III. Discussion of Possible Town Hall Meeting in 2001

Mr. Hobson asked if the committee should have a Town Hall meeting in 2001. Mr. Vernon Grigg suggested that the committee define the purpose of the Town Hall meeting and define a follow-up action plan and a feedback plan for the Town Hall meeting. Ms. Mathis informed the committee that the Youth Commission plans to have a Town Hall meeting in January 2001 and that the Youth Commission has received the Board's Annual Recommendations and Priorities. Ms. Mathis stated that she will follow-up with the Director of the Youth Commission, Ms. Colleen Montoya.
