

San Francisco Food Security Coordination Subcommittee
Proposed Recommendations to the Food Security Task Force

The Food Security Coordination Subcommittee was charged by the Food Security Task Force to provide recommendations to the Task Force on what oversight structure would best monitor and ensure the implementation of recommendations from other Task Force subcommittees. Following are our recommendations for approval by the Task Force for inclusion in its report to the Board of Supervisors.

Recommendation # 1

The Mayor and the Board of Supervisors should issue a joint statement supporting the final report of the Task Force. This should be a public event in which the government of the City and County of San Francisco proclaims that it shall be City and County public policy to guarantee food security to all residents of San Francisco.

Recommendation # 2

The Mayor and the Board of Supervisors should jointly appoint a Food Security Oversight Board consisting of non-elected community leaders to monitor the status of food security, evaluate current and future strategies for achieving food security, and prepare semi-annual reports to the Mayor and the Board.
