#1 What can the Department do over the next five years to meet your health needs?

- **Develop clinics – especially for latch-key kids**
- **Support existing services and plan for what's being developed**
e.g., Sledge Lock development
- **Ensure patient-friendly environments)**
e.g., security at SFGH
- **Develop neighborhood clinics that multi purpose, including immunizations and services other than just primary care**

#2 What can the Department do over the next five years to prevent disease and injury among you and your family?

- **School nurses are front-line for detecting and preventing illness**

#3 What can the Department do over the next five years to use resources cost-effectively and efficiently?

- **Continue to invest in infrastructure and budget for maintenance – facilities look shoddy**
- **Work with S.F. Housing Authority for the Direct Access to Housing**
- **Expand the Lifetime Clinical Record to all providers**
e.g., mental health, substance abuse, etc.

#4 What can the Department do over the next five years to engage with your community?

- **Go out to community meetings to advise of programs that are available**
e.g., Senior Injury Prevention
