



Notice of Suspension or Restrictions of Indoor Activity

November 16, 2020

San Francisco is experiencing a rapid and significant surge in COVID-19 cases. This rise in cases means that San Francisco’s health metrics meet the criteria to be moved from the “yellow” or minimal tier of the State’s color-coded risk framework to a more restrictive tier. Unless San Francisco takes action to stop the increase in cases, San Francisco risks falling into more restrictive categories. Accordingly, the Health Officer is suspending or restricting certain indoor activities. If the surge in cases continues, the Health Officer may, starting with additional indoor activities, further restrict or suspend other activities currently allowed under Health Officer Order C19-07 as may be amended.

Important Note: Effective as noted in the table below, the Health Officer ordered suspensions or restrictions on capacity limits of the activities as shown in the table below. These suspensions or restrictions amend any related orders, directives, or guidance. All impacted people and entities are required to adhere to these new limits and must otherwise continue to monitor and comply with all applicable [Health Orders](#) and [Directives](#).
