Missing DSM-5 Diagnosis Reports

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Policy

A DSM-5/ICD-10 diagnosis must be added for all clients receiving services on and after 10/1/2015, in accordance with federal regulations. You are not required to enter a DSM-5/ICD-10 diagnosis for clients discharged prior to 10/1/2015.

Missing DSM-5 Diagnosis Reports Now Available

The reports described below were created to assist clinic managers and licensed clinicians in identifying clients with an open episode who do not yet have a primary diagnosis with DSM-5/ICD-10 codes. Below the name of each Admitting/Primary Clinician practicing at a clinic, clients in their caseload appear in one of two lists:

- a) DSM-5/ICD-10 Not Completed
- b) DSM-5/ICD-10 Completed

Use the "Diagnosis" form in Avatar to add a DSM-5/ICD-10 diagnosis code when needed. The "DSM-5/ICD-10 Completed" section lists clients **with** a DSM-5/ICD-10 code as their primary diagnosis. No further action is required on clients/diagnoses in this list.

Report Location Avatar CWS / Reports

1. Missing DSM-5 Diagnosis by Program/Staff Report

- Report is available to clinic supervisors and designated administrative staff.
- Report lists all clients with an open admission/episode at a program, sorted by Admitting/Primary Clinician.

2. Missing DSM-5/ICD-10 Diagnosis by Clinician Report

- Clinician requests this report to view status of clients/diagnoses in their caseload.
- If clinician practices in multiple programs, the report separates clients by program.

3. Missing DSM-5/ICD-10 Diagnosis by Clinician, Supervisor Report

- Report is available to supervisors and designated administrative staff, who run the report for one clinician, at one program.

Report Highlights

- A "Clinician Summary" box appears below the list of clients showing the number and percentage of clients in caseloads with and without a DSM-5/ICD10 diagnosis.
- A "Program Summary" at the end of the "Diagnosis by Program/Staff report" shows the number and percentage of clients with and without DSM-5/ICD10 diagnosis for the whole program.
- Extensive Notes appear on the last page to explain report contents and further action required.
