Adult / Older Adult Consumer Experience Report - Spring 2014

This report covers surveys returned for program codes (RUs): 38ADM1. The number of clients receiving face-to-face services during the survey period was 15 and surveys were returned for 14 of those served (93.3%). Number of survey client IDs matched to service data: 14 (93.3%). Number missing client ID (BIS number): 0. The mean MHSIP satisfaction score (items 1-3, 5-20) for JFCS Adult Outpatient Mental Health - Judah was **4.86** out of five, and the mean for all other programs was **4.31**.

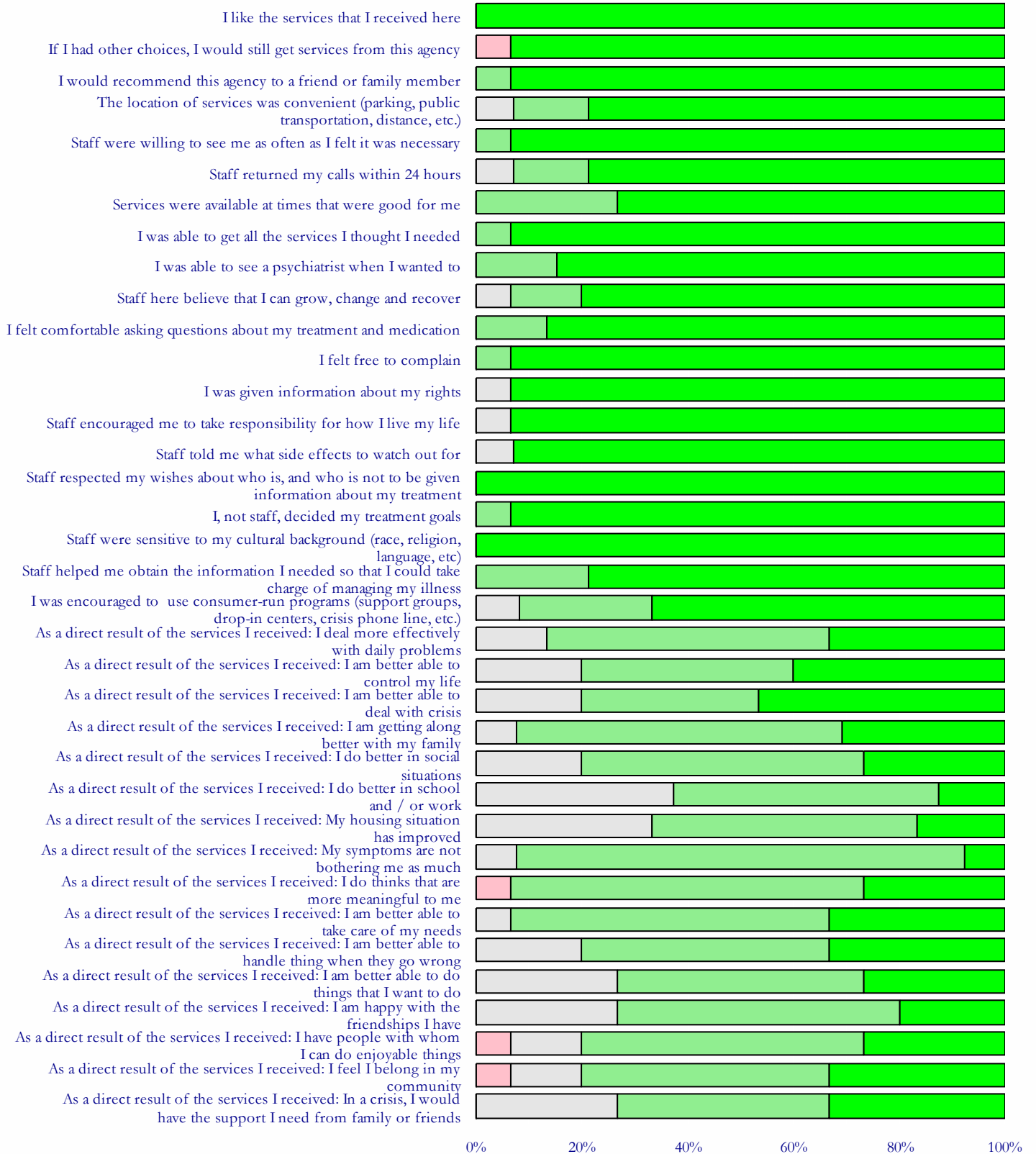
