



PF Dore House Crisis Residential Program and Outpatient

Adult / Older Adult Consumer Experience Report - Spring 2014

This report covers surveys returned for program codes (RUs): 38GM3. The number of clients receiving face-to-face services during the survey period was 16 and surveys were returned for 19 of those served (118.8%). Number of survey client IDs matched to service data: 15 (93.8%). Number missing client ID (BIS number): 0. The mean MHSIP satisfaction score (items 1-3, 5-20) for PF Dore House Crisis Residential Program and Outpatient was **3.91** out of five, and the mean for all other programs was **4.32**.

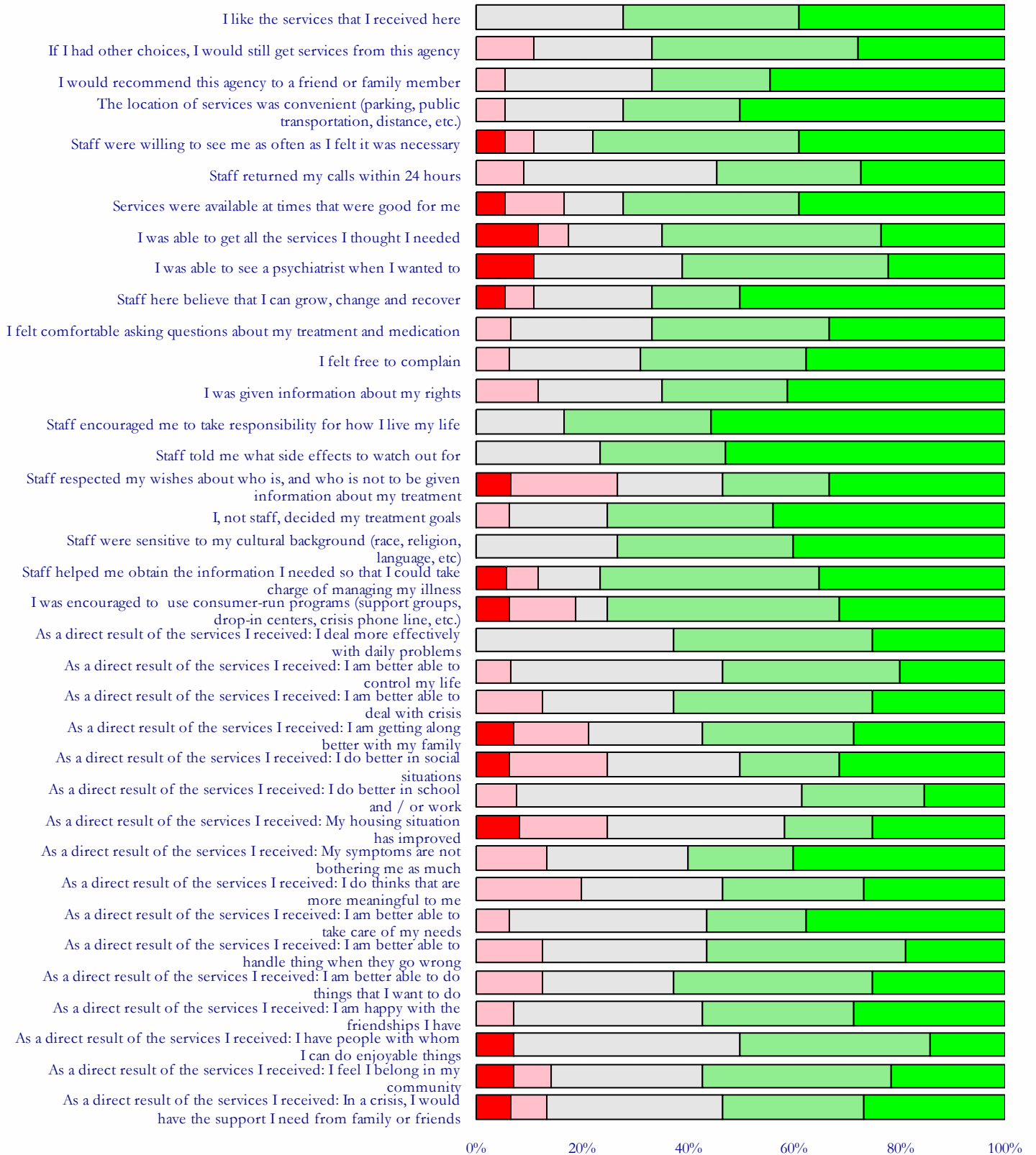
