



### Southeast Mission Geriatric Services

#### Adult / Older Adult Consumer Experience Report - Spring 2014

This report covers surveys returned for program codes (RUs): 38483. The number of clients receiving face-to-face services during the survey period was 51 and surveys were returned for 27 of those served (52.9%). Number of survey client IDs matched to service data: 23 (45.1%). Number missing client ID (BIS number): 0. The mean MHSIP satisfaction score (items 1-3, 5-20) for Southeast Mission Geriatric Services was **4.57** out of five, and the mean for all other programs was **4.31**.

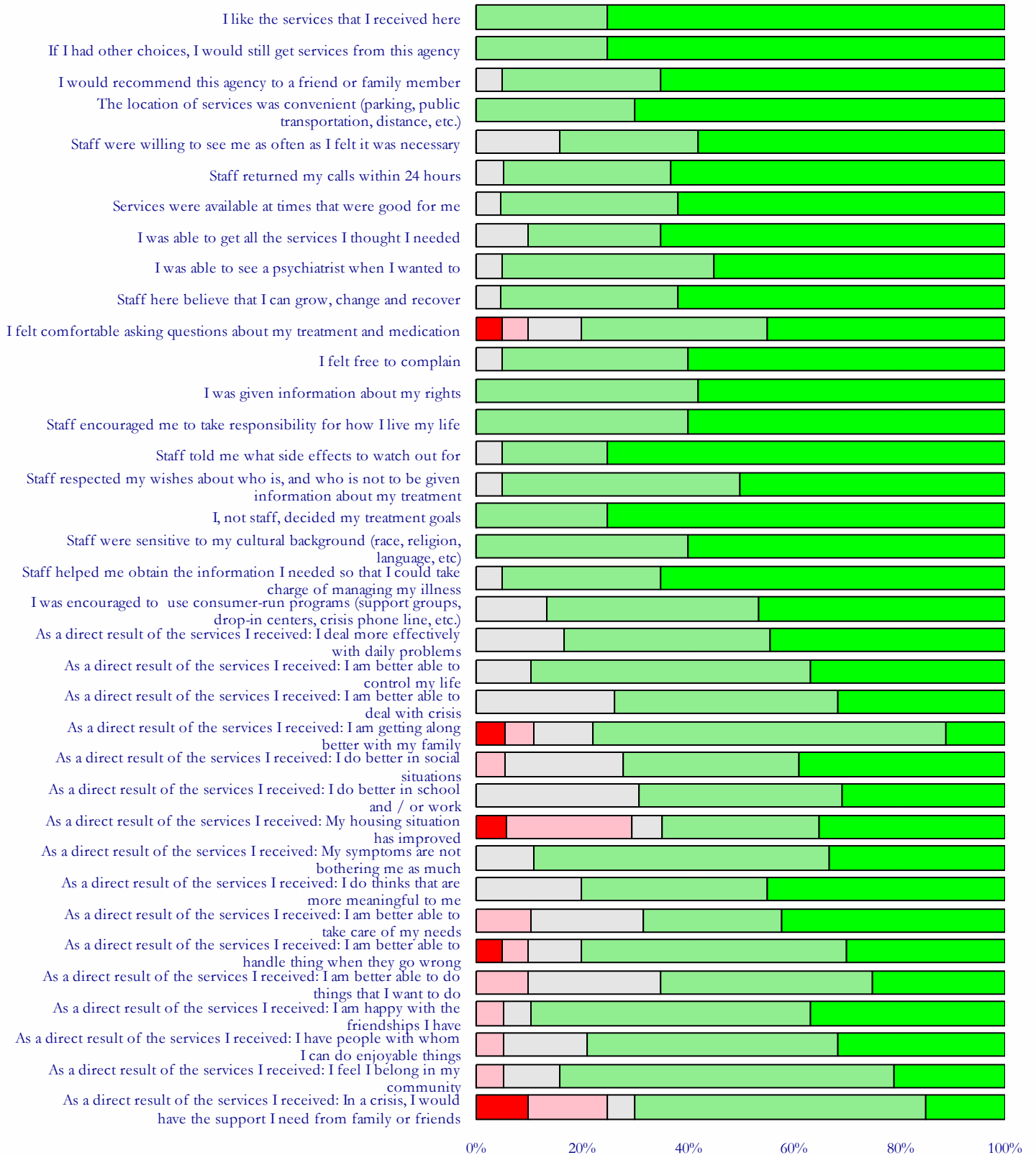
