This report covers surveys returned for program codes (RUs): 38GC3. The number of youth receiving face-to-face services during the survey period was 7 and surveys were returned for 7 youth (100.0%). Number of surveys matched to service data: 7 (100.0%). Number missing client ID: 0. The YSS score (items 1-7, 9-15) for this program, was **4.62** out of five, the mean for all other programs was **4.23**. The mean YSS-F satisfaction score (items 1-7, 9-15) for this program was **4.89**, the mean of all other programs was **4.32**.

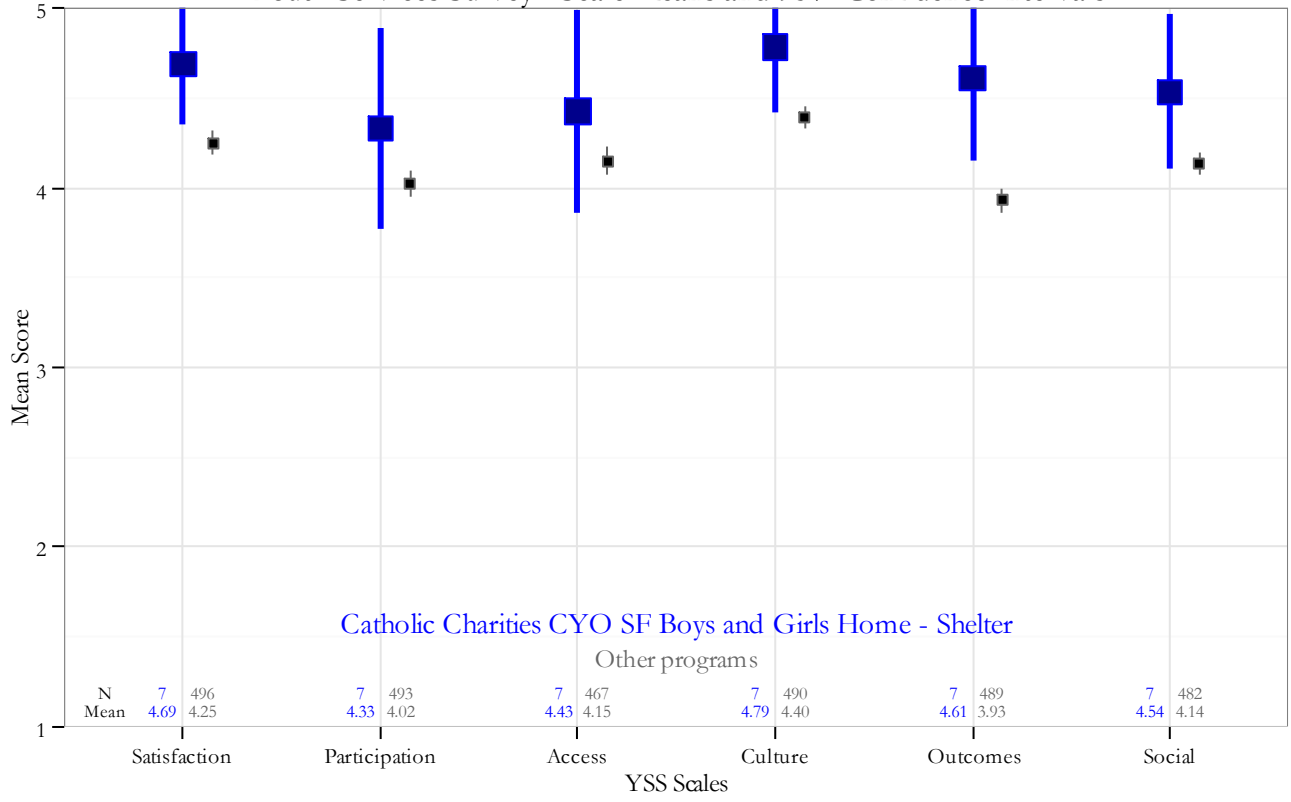

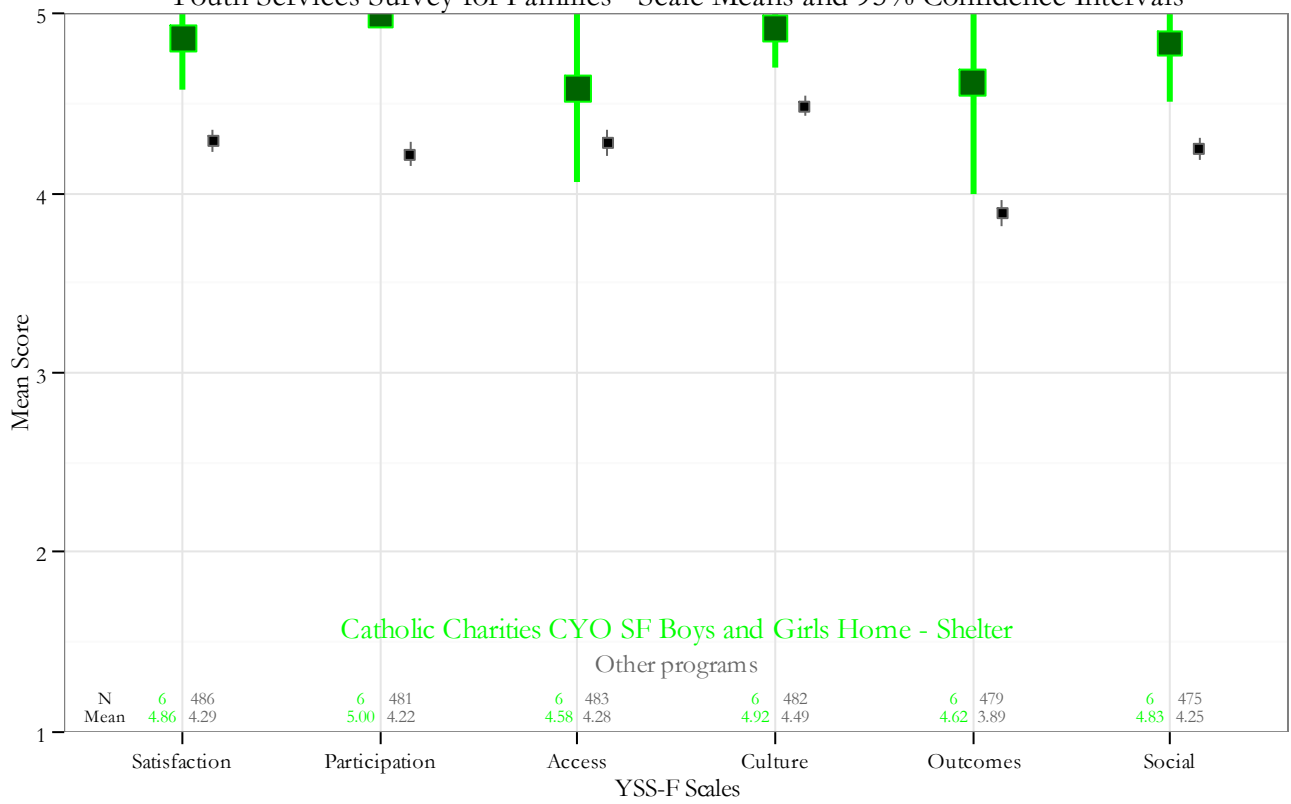

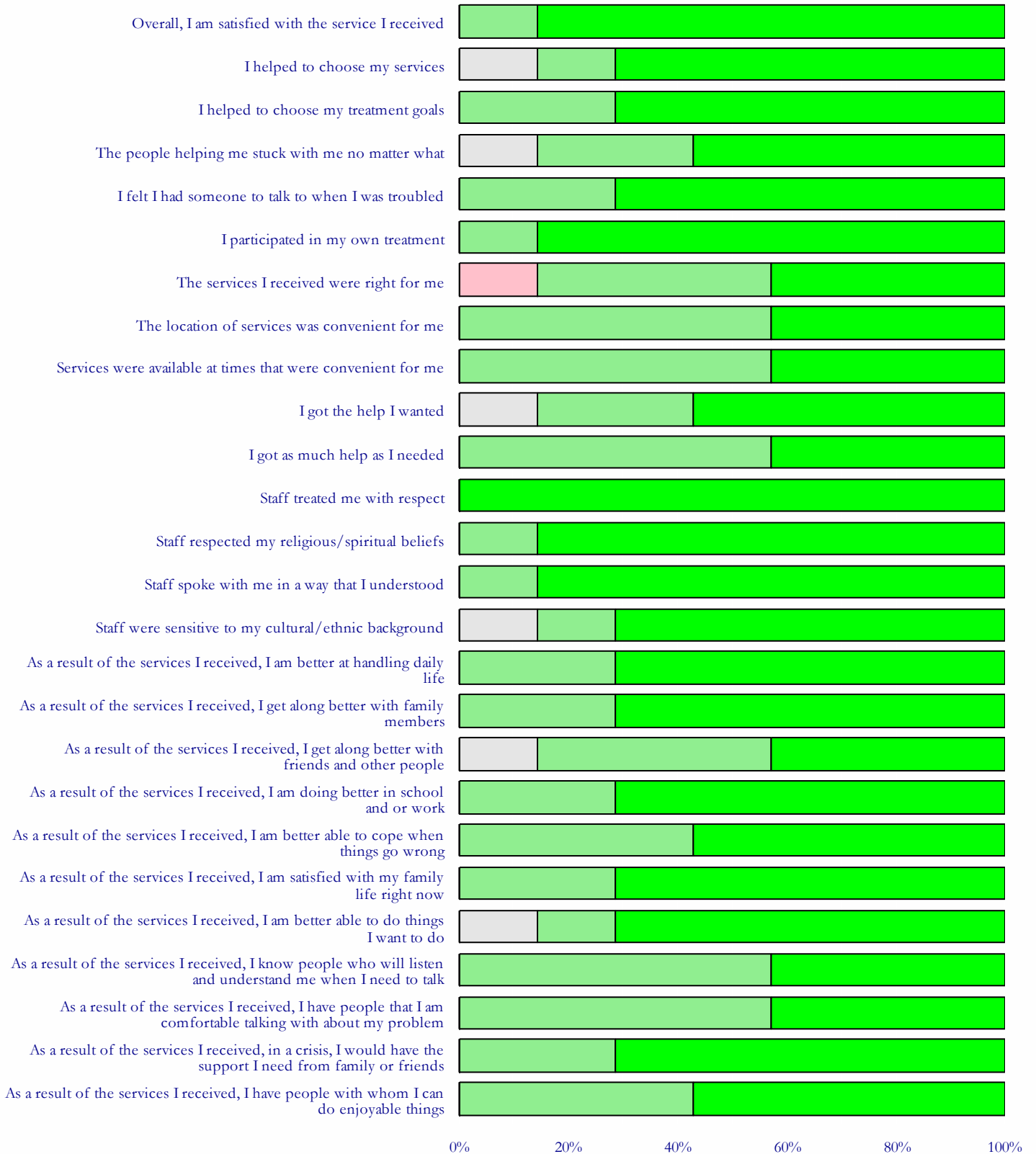
Youth Services Survey - Scale Means and 95% Confidence Intervals



Youth Services Survey for Families - Scale Means and 95% Confidence Intervals



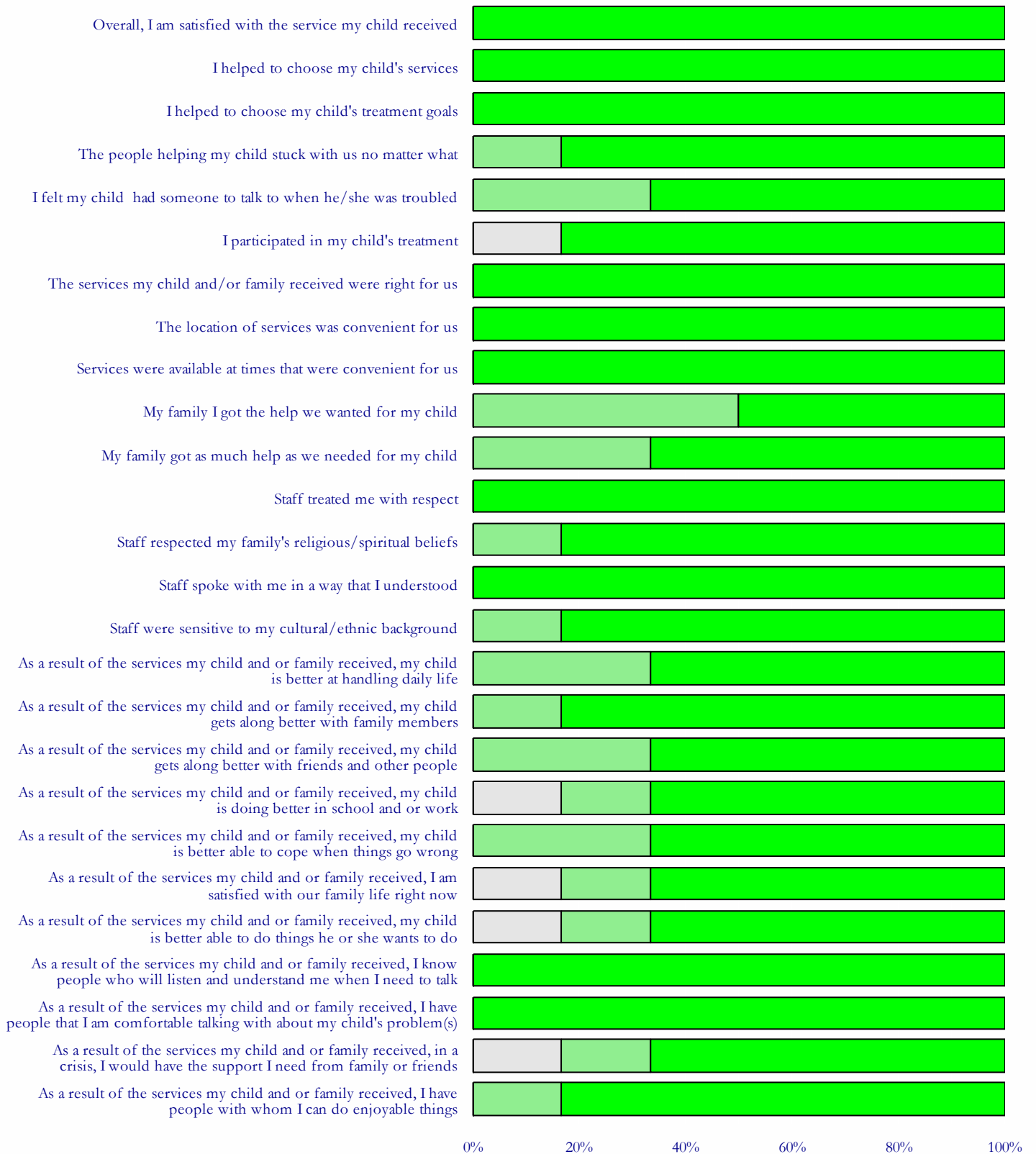
