## ***Meeting Accessibility***

### Wheelchair Accessibility

The first issue-based meeting of the Health Care Services Master Plan (HCSMP) Task Force will take place at San Francisco City Hall, Room 305. San Francisco City Hall, located at 1 Dr. Carlton B. Goodlett Place, has wheelchair accessible entrances on all four sides, and the third floor is accessible via elevator. The closest accessible station for Muni and BART is the Civic Center station. The nearest accessible BART station is Civic Center (Market/Grove/Hyde Streets). Accessible MUNI Metro lines are the J, K, L, M, and N (Civic Center or Van Ness Stations). MUNI bus lines serving the area are the 47 Van Ness, 9 San Bruno, and the 6, 7, 71 Haight/Noriega. For more information about MUNI accessible services, please call (415) 923-6142. There is accessible parking in the vicinity of City Hall at Civic Center Plaza and adjacent to Davies Hall and the War Memorial Complex. Accessible curbside parking is available on Dr. Carlton B. Goodlett Place and Grove Street and at the southwest corner of Grove and Polk Streets.
