




### Highest level of education attained, 2000<sup>1</sup>




Population living below 200% of the Census poverty threshold and median HH income, 2005-09<sup>2</sup>











#### Pediatric asthma hospitalizations per 10,000, 2009<sup>4</sup>




#### Leading emergency room visits per 10,000, 2009<sup>4</sup>









# Safety in Your Neighborhood

Residents' perceived safety during day (2011)<sup>11</sup>







Percent of mothers who receive NO prenatal care in the first trimester, 2009<sup>9</sup>
