PREVENTIVE DENTAL CARE – Children with Special Health Care Needs

Below is a list of Registered Dental Hygienists in Alternative Practice (RDHAP) who provide preventive dental treatment in-home services to children with special needs. An RDHAP is a licensed dental hygienist who has received additional training and licensure in working with special needs populations. An RDHAP works with an associated dentist, with whom consultations and referrals can be made.

RDHAPs generally have portable dental equipment and can provide a dental cleaning, dental hygiene exam, fluoride treatments and take x-rays. They are well versed in techniques to help pre-cooperative patients feel comfortable enough to receive preventive dental services. The goal is to prevent the necessity for restorative and more complicated dental treatment. An RDHAP does not take the place of a dentist. They provide preventive care to keep the child's teeth healthy.
