Analyses are based on one record per live birth delivered in California. The top table shows the total number of live births stratified by 1st Trimester Prenatal Care. The bottom table shows the percentage of births in each calendar year by 1st Trimester Prenatal Care with 95% Confidence Interval. Analyses exclude records for births delivered out-of-state, births to people who are not San Francisco residents, and records with unknown data or errors. Data are not reported for fewer than 20 records.
