? What Family Planning Services are offered?

Services for Men & Women:

- Yearly exams
- Birth control and counseling
- Screening, testing, and treatment for Sexually Transmitted Infections
- HIV screening, counseling, and testing
- Infertility counseling and testing
- Information and referral for sterilization

Services for Women Only:

- Pap smears
- Breast exams
- Pregnancy tests
- Dysplasia screening and treatment at some sites

All services are confidential.

? Who can receive Family Planning Services?

Eligibility Requirements:

- Women (up to 55 years of age)
- Men (up to 60 years of age)
- Teens (12 years and older)
- At risk of pregnancy or causing pregnancy
- Must live in California
- Must meet income levels
