1. San Francisco residents
2. 18 years and over
3. Insured with Managed Medi-Cal OR Enrolled in Healthy SF, Healthy Workers, or Healthy Families

How do I Get Referred?

- 1 Engagement in primary care in SF for 1 year (3 months for Top Surgeries).
- 2 Tell your provider you are interested in surgery.
- 3 Medical evaluation, patient education, and referral by primary care provider.
- 4 1 or 2 pre-surgical assessments (depends on surgery). Letters are completed by a licensed mental health provider(s).
- 5 Once the medical and mental health portion is complete, primary care will referral you to Gender Health SF.
- 6 You will be required to do an orientation and an intake. You will be assigned a Peer Navigator to help coordinate care and navigate you to surgery.
- 7 You will receive education and preparation programming to prepare while waiting for surgery.

How Long Will I Wait for Surgery?

Waiting times for surgery depend on procedure requested, type of health coverage, and surgeon availability.
