## **SAN FRANCISCO LOBBYIST ORDINANCE**

Lobbyist individualistically entities that influence or attempt to influence local legislative or administrative action may be required by the San Francisco Lobbyist Ordinance (Administrative Code Section 16.520-534) to register and report lobbying activity.
