ITEM 1.0 COMMISSIONER’S REPORTS

Discussion of BHC commissioner’s necessity to be informed of the DPH budget, the intention and how these dollars will be dispersed regarding new budget initiative

1.1 Reports from Chair of the Executive Committee Co-Chair Jackson-Lane thanked commissioners for their service and issued high hopes for the future and looking forward to the BHC retreat. Co-Chair Slota gave report on commissioner resignations primarily due to outside pressure and read a very passionate exit letter from Commissioner Fey. Co-Chair Jackson-Lane and Commissioner Bohrer suggested that a letter of appreciation should go out to Judy Drummond and Ashel Fey

1.2 Executive Director Grier noted that he has received notification from the Board of Supervisor clerk that new commissioner applications are in review

1.3 Vice-Chair Vigil to review BHC By-Laws before voting to move to full BHC for voting to pass on to city attorney for final review

Public Comment: Liza Murawski stated that lack of oversight and failure of Behavioral Health Services (BHS) to include the Behavioral Health Commission (BHC) is detrimental
