**Wheelchair Accessibility**

The November 9, 2016, meeting of the San Francisco Cannabis State Legalization Task Force will take place at the San Francisco County Transportation Authority Hearing Room. It is located on the 22<sup>nd</sup> floor at 1455 Market Street, between 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> streets. The building and hearing room is fully accessible to persons using wheelchairs and other assistive mobility devices.

The nearest accessible BART station is Civic Center (Market/Grove/Hyde Streets). Accessible MUNI Metro lines are the J, K, L, M, and N (Civic Center or Van Ness Stations). MUNI bus lines serving the area are the 47 Van Ness, 9 San Bruno, and the 6, 7, 71 Haight/Noriega. For more information about MUNI accessible services, please call (415) 923-6142. For information about MUNI services, please call (415) 673-6864. Parking is available in the lobby level garage. Garage hours are 6am–10pm, Monday-Friday. Public parking rates are \$2 for 30 minutes and \$20 for up to 12 hours. Early Bird parking (in by 8:00 am/out by 6:00 pm) is \$12. (Rates are subject to change.)
