# **Non-Gift Fund Donations**

In addition to donations to its Gift Fund, LHH received in-kind donations and a donation to the Employee Development Fund in FY 2016-17.

Donations of items from the public are regularly received by our Volunteer Services Department. Those donations include clothing, books, magazines, durable medical equipment, small household items, etc. Most donated items are distributed directly to the neighborhoods and the residents. Items not distributed to the residents and neighborhoods are placed in the Gift Shop as sale items. Proceeds from the sale of donated items are deposited into the Gift Fund, resulting in \$2,759 in revenue for the Gift Fund in FY 2016-17.

#### Friends of Laguna Honda

Friends of Laguna Honda, a non-profit organization founded in 1956, is dedicated to enhancing the quality of life for the residents at Laguna Honda Hospital by funding non-medical programs and services that would otherwise be unavailable.
