Workgroup Duties

Established by BOS Ordinance 108-19

Purpose

- Conduct evaluation on effectiveness of Housing Conservatorship implementation, and submit reports to the BOS, Mayor, and State Legislature, as required
 - Annual report to BOS and Mayor by January 21 each year
 - Annual reports to the State by January 1 each year

Data Review

Ongoing and Future Data Collection

- **Ongoing analysis of client-level data.** Including analysis of changes in client outcomes and the overall demographic landscape of those conserved under Housing Conservatorship pilot program
- **Ongoing analysis of population-level data.** Including annual population-level counts of 5150s
- **Individual client feedback.** Including surveys and/or interviews will be conducted with individuals conserved, to gauge overall experience and attitude toward the pilot program
- **Stakeholder feedback.** Data collection with stakeholders to gauge impressions of the pilot and suggestions for improvement

For individual client and stakeholder feedback

Questions to consider

- Data collected methods: Surveys, focus groups, interviews, or any combination of these data collection methods?
- Key stakeholders: Individual clients, family members, service partners, and other stakeholders?
