<p style="text-align: center;"><b>3</b></p> <p>A student or staff member had close contact* with someone who had close contact* with someone who had COVID-19</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Student/staff member may return to school/class immediately without any special restrictions</li> <li>● Advise student/staff member to practice steps to stay healthy:               <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Physical distance 6 feet</li> <li>○ Wear a face covering</li> <li>○ Wash hands often with soap and water for 20 seconds or use hand sanitizer with 60% alcohol</li> <li>○ Avoid touching eyes, nose and mouth</li> </ul> </li> </ul> <p>*A <b>Close Contact</b> is defined as a person who spent at least 15 minutes within 6 feet of someone with COVID-19, whether all at one time or cumulatively, while the person was infectious. See Key Terms section (above) for more information.</p>	<p>Cohort/School/Site remains <b>OPEN</b></p> <p><b>Communication:</b> None required</p>
