# Quarterly Update

# Program Implementation

## Goals of BSCC LEAD Grant

---

- 1. Reduce the recidivism rate** for low-level drug and alcohol offenders in the Tenderloin and Mission districts
- 2. Strengthen collaboration** across city departments and with community-based organizations to better meet the needs of individuals with a history of substance abuse
- 3. Improve health and housing status** of LEAD participants

## Real time implementation update

---

### Seattle LEAD Police Officer Site Visit Recommendation

- Suggested change in tactic to step back from offering feedback regarding pre-booking referral targets
- Creates the opportunity for SF police officer to become familiar with and fully support LEAD program



## Update on pre-booking/social contact referrals

---

- Total of 163 referrals and 85 active participants as of : 7/19/2018

	<b>Pre-booking Referrals</b>	<b>Social Contact</b>	
Referrals	83 (51%)	80 (49%)	Number (Percent)
History of Contact with SF Jail System	58 of 83 (70%)	64 of 80 (80%)	

- Since our last meeting in April, we have made some progress in increasing the number and % of pre-booking referrals, which has been identified as the priority of the program.

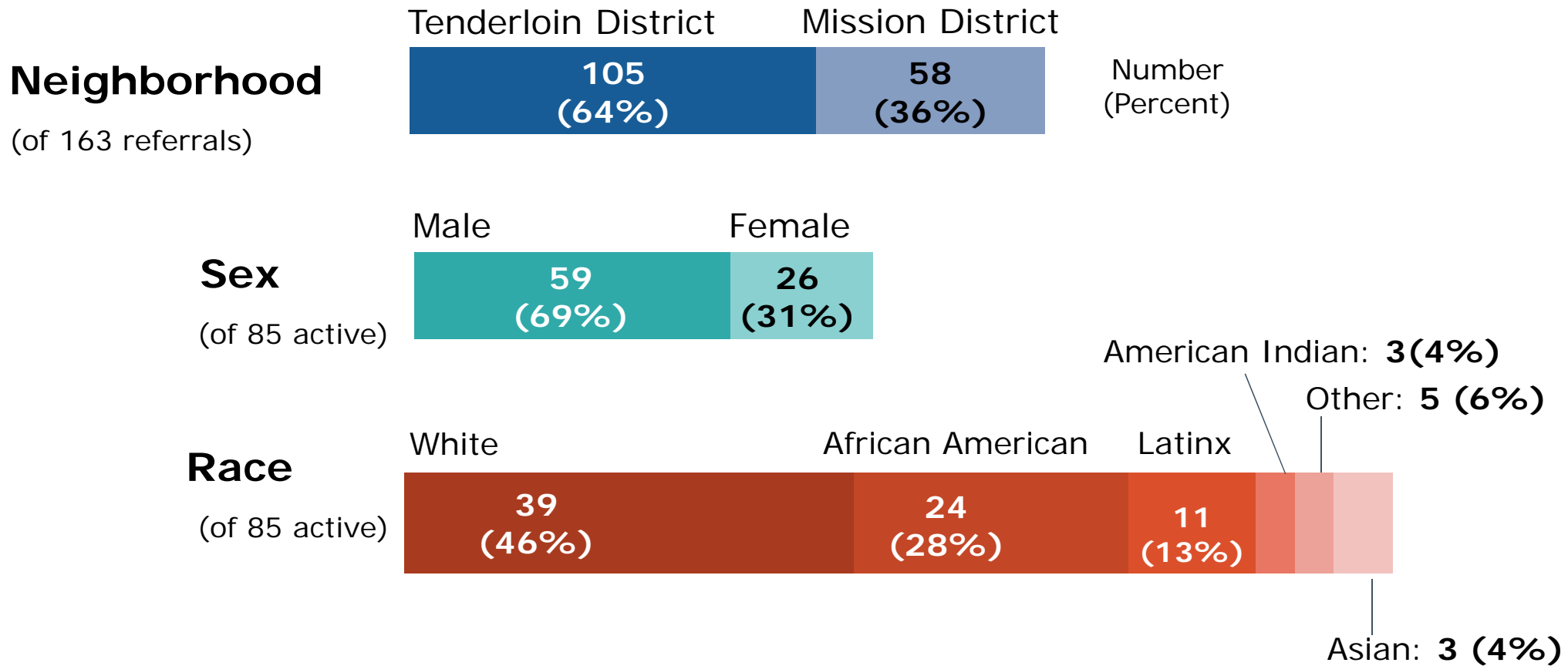

# Update on demographics



## Confirm expansion of charges with conditions

---

List of **approved expanded LEAD eligible charges\*** (with all **new** eligible charges permissible only as felonies):

- Vandalism with damages less than \$2000
- The following theft-related offenses with a loss under \$2000:
  - PC 484 (*including* credit card frauds)
  - PC 459 2nd (*including* auto burglary cases)
  - PC 470, 476, 477, 478, 487, 496, 666
  - VC 10852

\* These charges still fall under the requirement that behavior is believed to be related to subsistence living.

\*\*The expanded charges were approved via modified consensus at the last April 23 PC meeting with the condition to assess the impact of this expansion at the July 23 PC meeting, and with an opportunity to re-vote.
