Food Security Task Force (reauthorized until July 1, 2026)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Report to the Board of Supervisors legislative action and city-wide strategies that would increase participation in federally funded programs</li> <li>• Provide general advice and assistance to the Board of Supervisors with regard to funding priorities, legislative action, and City policies on addressing hunger and enhancing the food security</li> </ul>
Biennial Food Security and Equity Report (by October 1, 2023, and by October 1 every second year thereafter)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Assist the Department of Public Health in reviewing data and preparing and presenting the Biennial Food Security and Equity Report to the Board of Supervisors and Mayor</li> <li>• Assist the Department of Public Health in collecting data from non-City entities</li> </ul>
Food Empowerment Market Fund (rules are due no later than Feb. 30, 2022)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• HSA shall consult with the Food Security Task Force on the development of the rules for the Food Empowerment Market grant program, including consideration of the “2018 Assessment of Food Security” report issued by the Task Force.</li> </ul>
