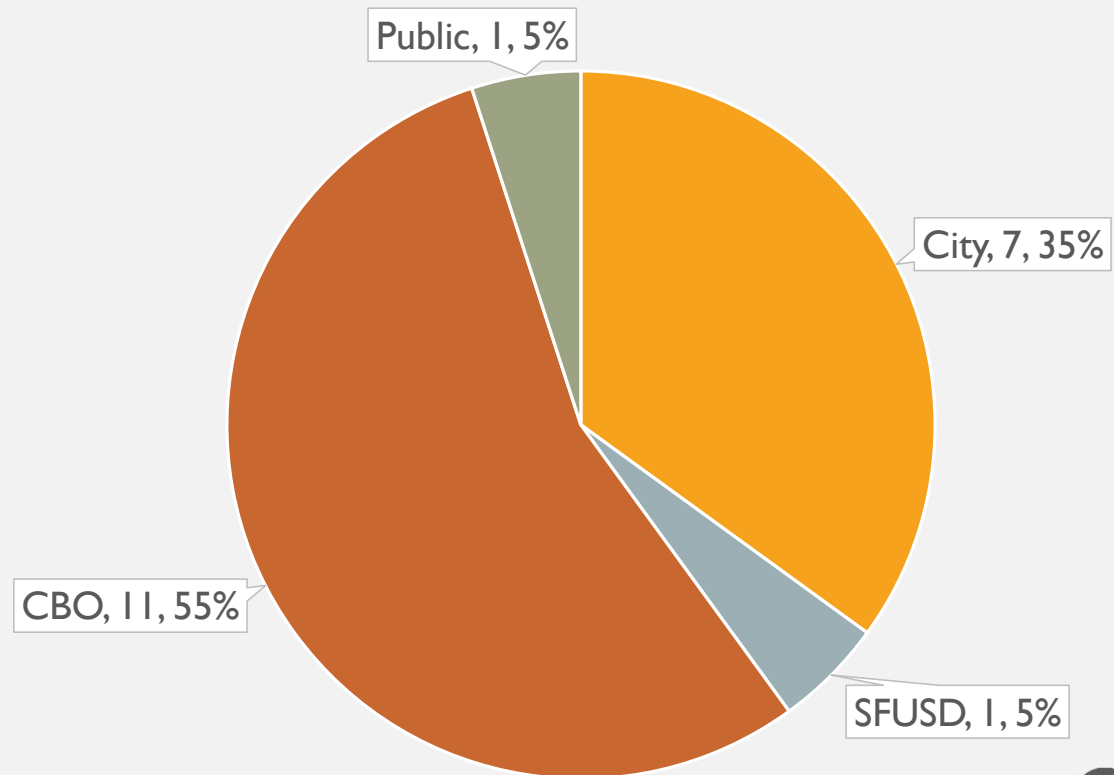

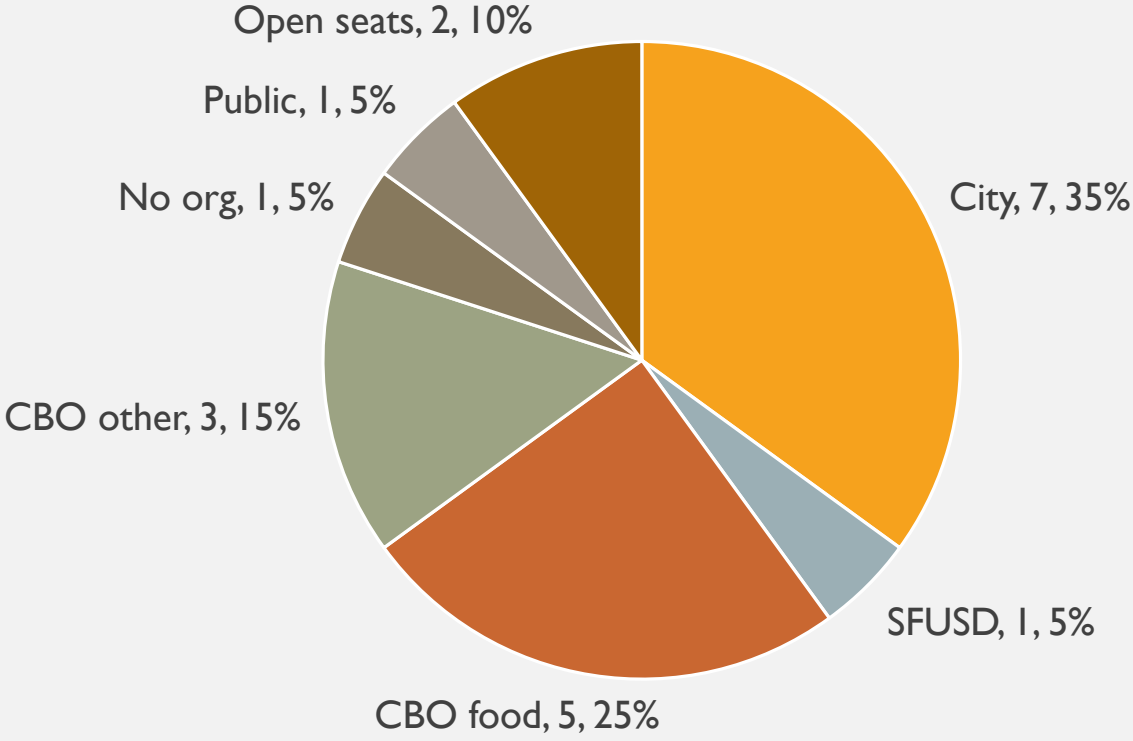
## CURRENT FSTF ORDINANCE - MEMBERSHIP SEATS

- These members may include but are not limited to representatives from organizations serving food in the following program types: home delivered meals; congregate meals for seniors; food bank; free dining room; multi-service agency serving families and youth; shelter meals; and faith-based organizations; food retail (farmers markets; grocery stores); and hospital and health clinics



# CURRENT TASK FORCE MEMBERSHIP

## FEEDBACK ON MEMBERSHIP(FROM MARCH 3; APRIL 12 FSTF MEETINGS)

### Task Force member feedback:

- Add seats for community impacted by food insecurity
- Add corner store/grocery store representative
- Add Office of Racial Equity as a member
- Add Office of Economic and Workforce Development (concerned raised in 4/12)
- Add group with expertise in food recovery
- Add seat for transportation, and a for profit seat
- Could there be funding for stipends to support community members to participate as members? (YES)
- Would like to see the community reflected – from the highest impacted neighborhoods
- Call out membership by neighborhood (example: Latino Task Force for Mission; what group for Bayview?)
- Designate a seat/CBO that serves specific populations (example pregnant and lactating people)
- Some existing members may need to cede seats to community members
- The Sugary Drink Distributor Tax Advisory Group added seats for 3 health equity coalitions.
- Need health equity seats
- Add the following groups: college students, SRO, TAY

### Public comment:

- Likes adding membership seats for folks most impacted, corner stores, and OEWD
- Don't agree that the task force should be tied to the length of the pandemic
- Need to have an odd number of seats
- Could there be a second seat for SFUSD
- Add seat for immigrant population
- Expand to marginalized communities / Shift seats to community

### SUGGESTED CHANGES:

- Some seats represent specific population groups
- Need representation from specific neighborhoods
- Explore funding stipends for some seats

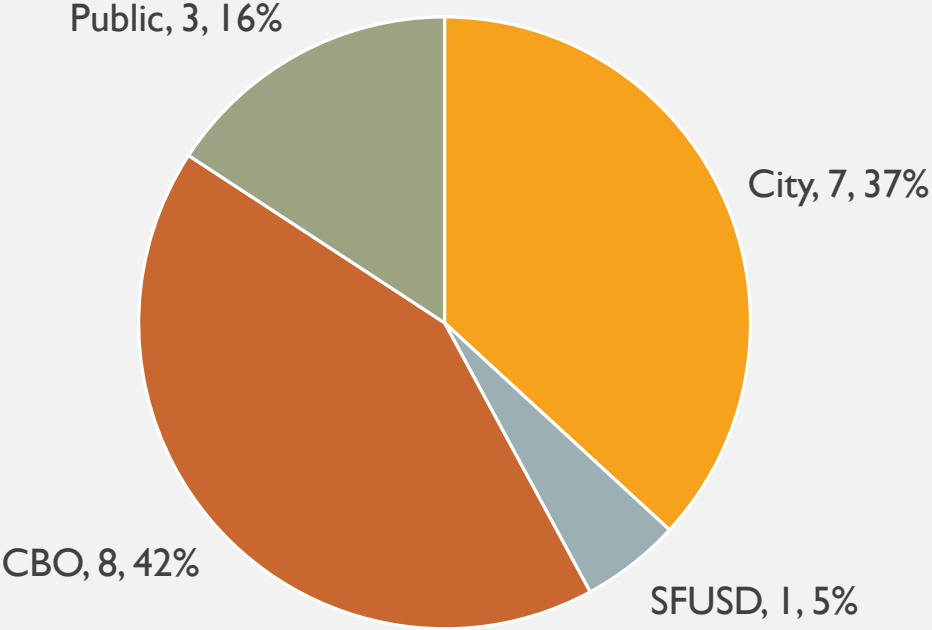
## RECOMMENDATIONS FOR MEMBERSHIP

- Have odd number of seats
- Add Office of Racial Equity
- Remove 1 DPH seat so that DPH has only 1 seat
- Add more dedicated seats for members of the public / experience of food insecurity
