CAH Fresh is working with the Food Bank and other CBO’s There have been eight enrollment events 20% of the original 40K are ineligible. 94124 and 94134 have high application rates Education staff to address fear of Public Charge Rule. Few people to date have been affected by rule change. Updated materials will be sent to the FSTF.
