What: Parents can Save \$70 on Mandatory Vaccine for kids 7-12 Grades
FREE Tdap (pertussis vaccine booster) Clinic tomorrow

This free clinic is being offered in response to the new California school immunization law (AB 354) requiring all students entering 7th-12th grades in the fall of 2011 to show proof of a Tdap shot (pertussis vaccine booster). Children without proof of a Tdap vaccination will be denied school entry. This law affects an estimated 25,000 students in San Francisco.

No reservations required. Drop in 11 a.m. - 4 p.m.

The free Tdap vaccination clinic is open to San Francisco students entering 7th-12th grades in the fall.
