(EMS6, Street Medicine, SFHOT)

The High Intensity Care Team is an interagency response for our most vulnerable clients experiencing homelessness. Mobile providers engage, stabilize, and connect clients to services needed to get and keep them in housing or other safe settings. The team is available 7 days a week from 6am to 2am.

If you have an interaction with or knowledge of a “Shared Priority” individual or need an immediate response because a client will be discharged or lost to follow-up, contact the High Intensity Care Team.
