





SO/GI Results: Sexual Minority Population SO/GI & GENDER IDENTITY











SO/GI Results: Gender Minority Population SO/GI






% Gender Minority (Transgender, Gender Non-Binary) as of 5/30/2019




SO/GI Results: May Snapshot sexual orientation




