




Who Do We Serve?



Age


Top Diagnoses






We Deliver Quality Outcomes Cancer Screening

Challenges

- Access to bilingual/bicultural, primary care services in other district health centers
- Timely access to primary care services
- Timely access to specialty/diagnostic services at SFGH
- Lack of adult dental services
- Lack of onsite behavioral health services
- Limited resources to assume the "public health" liaison role to the Chinese community
- Fragmented clinical information systems
- An aging Chinatown community and the need for geriatric clinical services and expertise
- Civil service personnel constraints
- Access to bilingual/bicultural health end materials

Strategic Priorities

- Implement electronic health record
- Integrate behavioral health & primary care
- Collaborate with IOA to screen older adults for behavioral health problems
- Transition to advance access scheduling
- Redesign PC services to be client-centered, population-focused, team-based and data-driven
- Continue to engage the community:
 - Disaster response preparedness
 - Obesity prevention
 - Caner disparities advocacy and research
 - "Public health" liaison and leadership
