He also argued that the county would receive more funds from state and federal programs if inmate-patients were taken out of the criminal justice system and put into the public health system.

Moreover, Peters argued, there are serious medical questions that make local mental health care

The quality of care is better in the home community, he said, because it frequently allows mak-ing use of already established family and clinical contacts, it eliminates the stigma of being "put away in a state hospital," and removes the psychologically hazardous uprooting of the patient from familiar surroundings.


