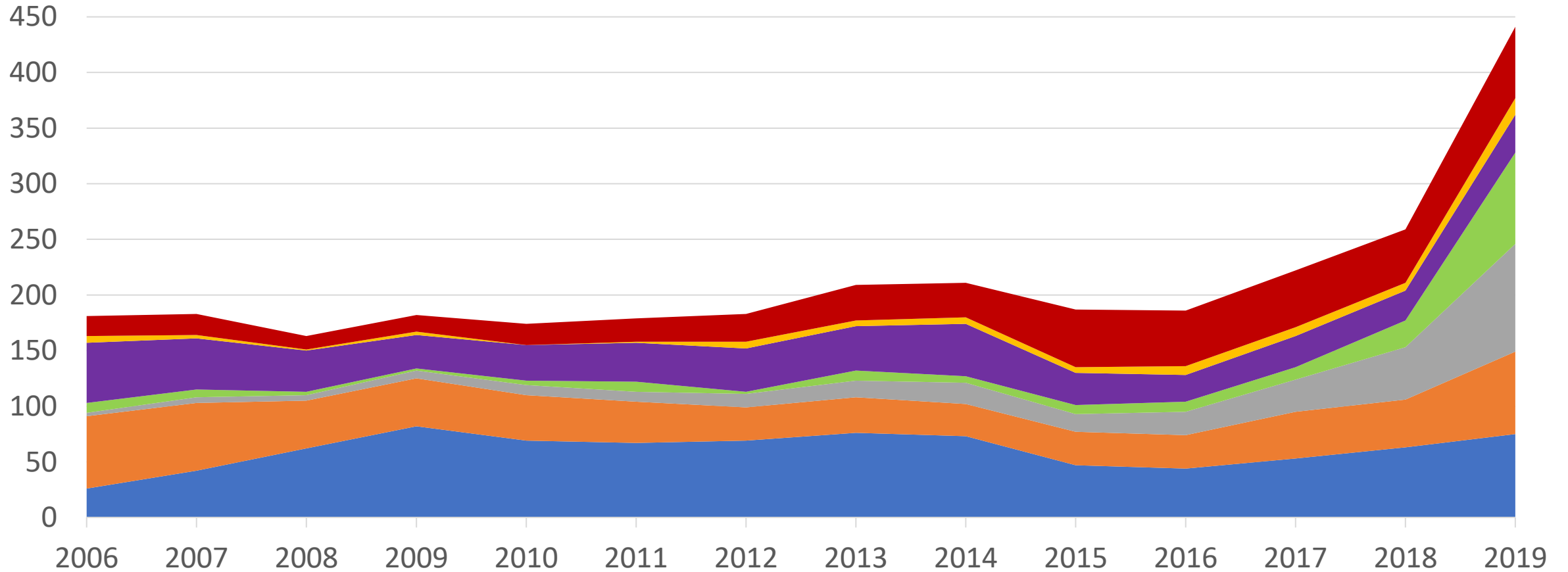

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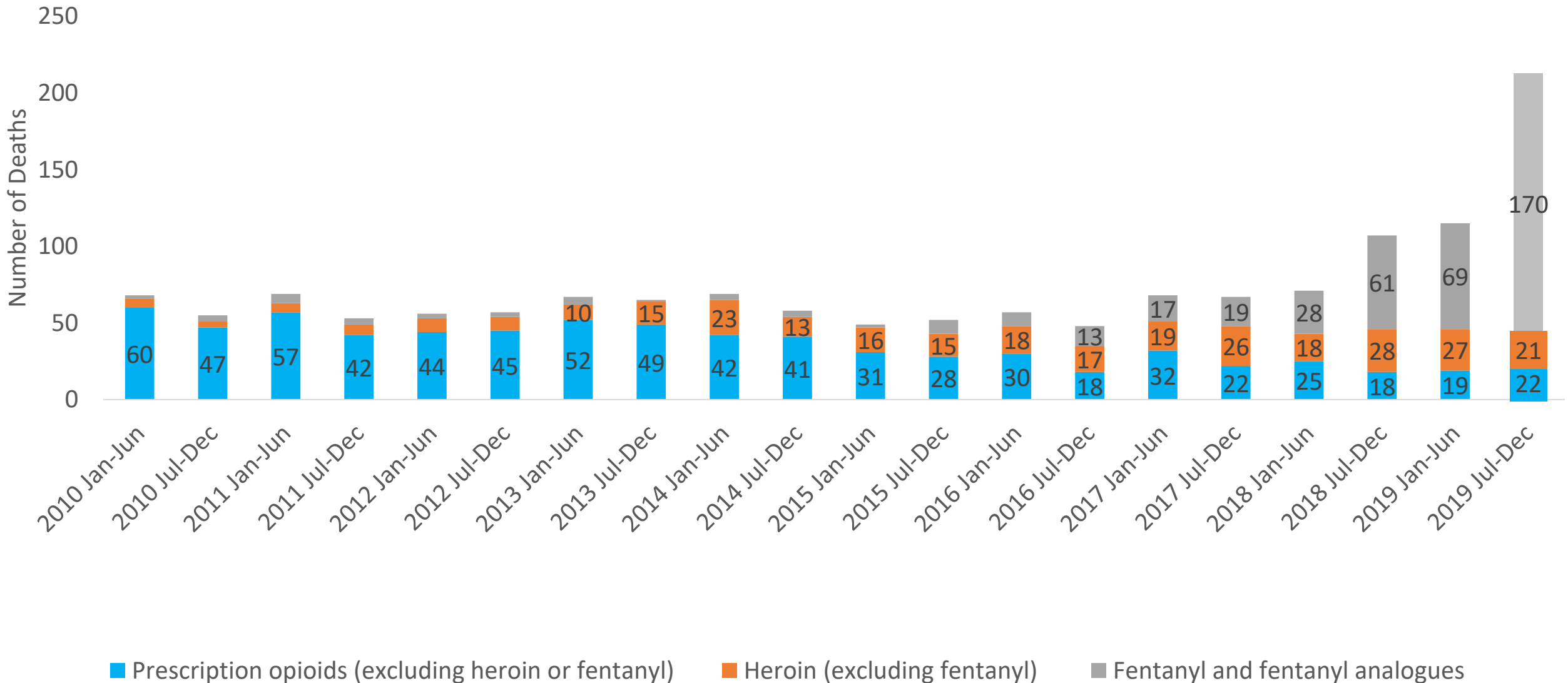
# Mutually Exclusive Acute Poisoning Deaths from Opioids and Stimulants in SF



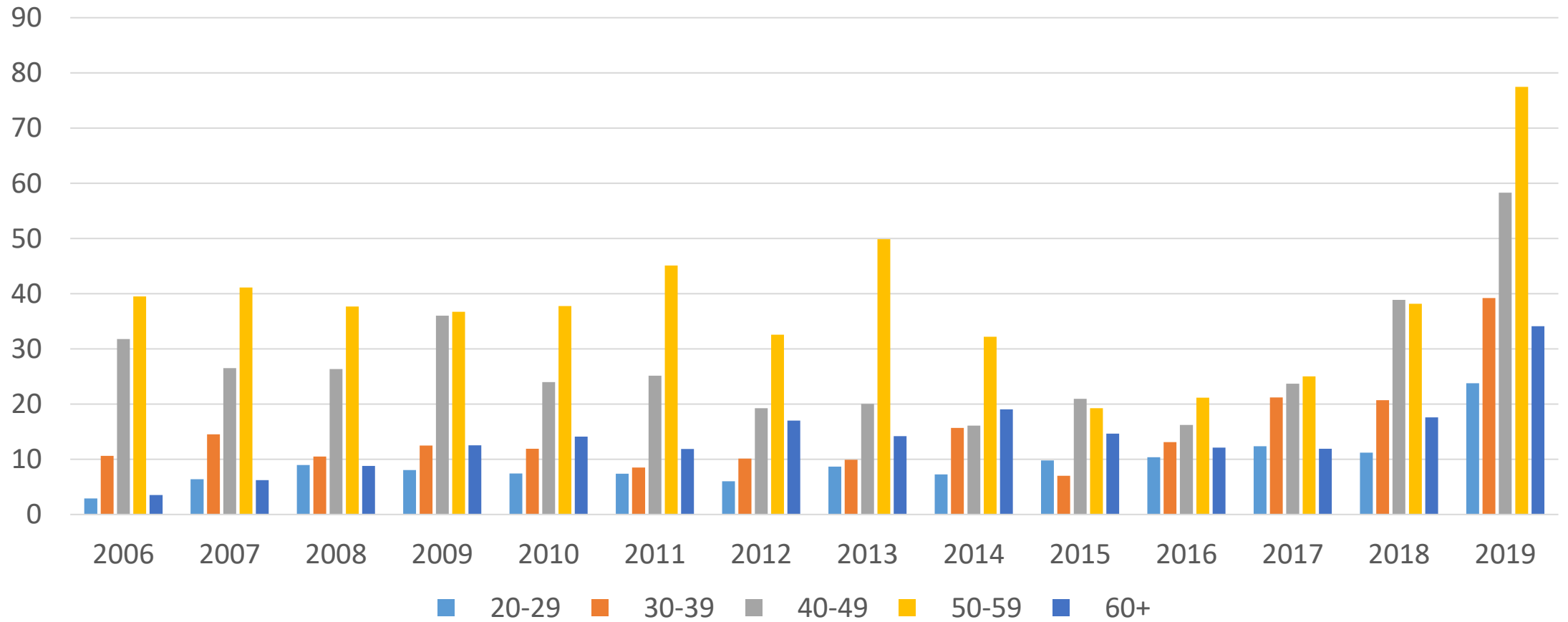
- Opioids only (no cocaine or methamphetamine)

- Cocaine and methamphetamine (no opioids)

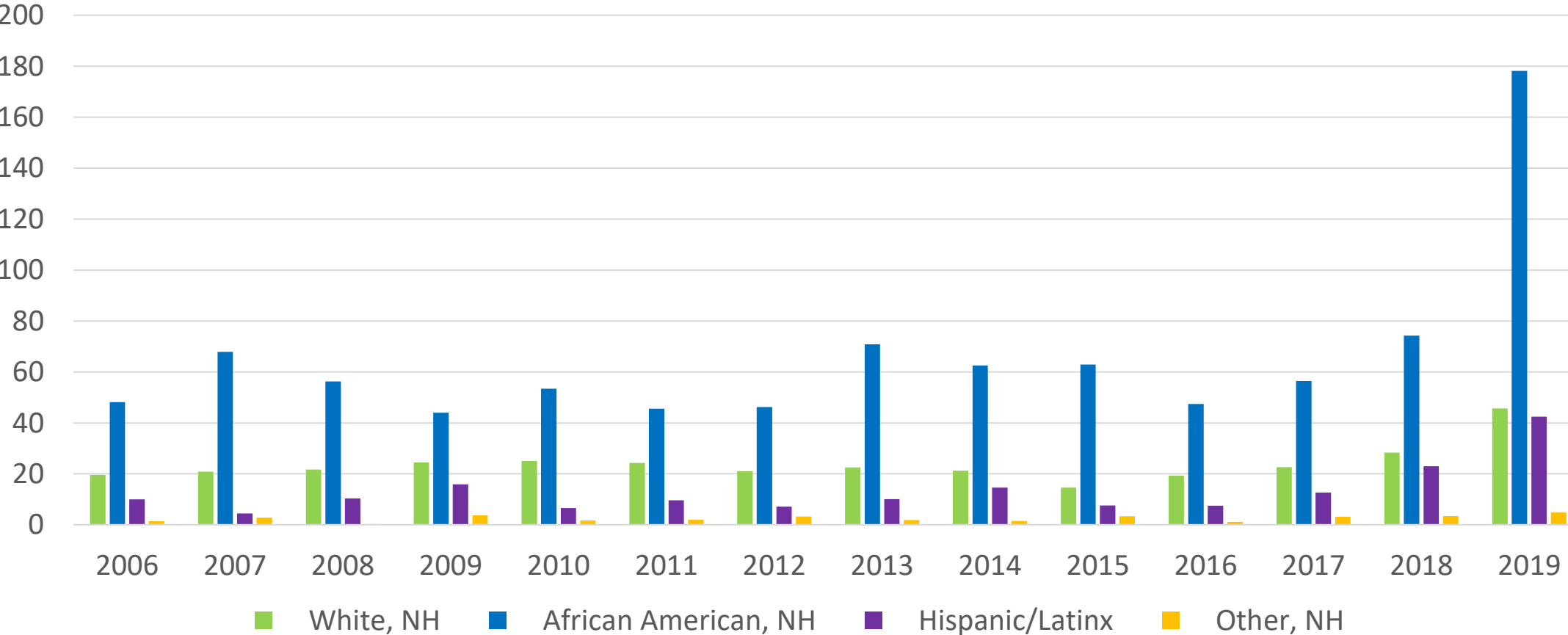
# Number of Opioid Overdose Deaths by Mutually Exclusive Opioid Type and Half-Year in San Francisco



# Rate per 100,000 Population of Opioid Overdose Deaths in San Francisco, 2006-2019

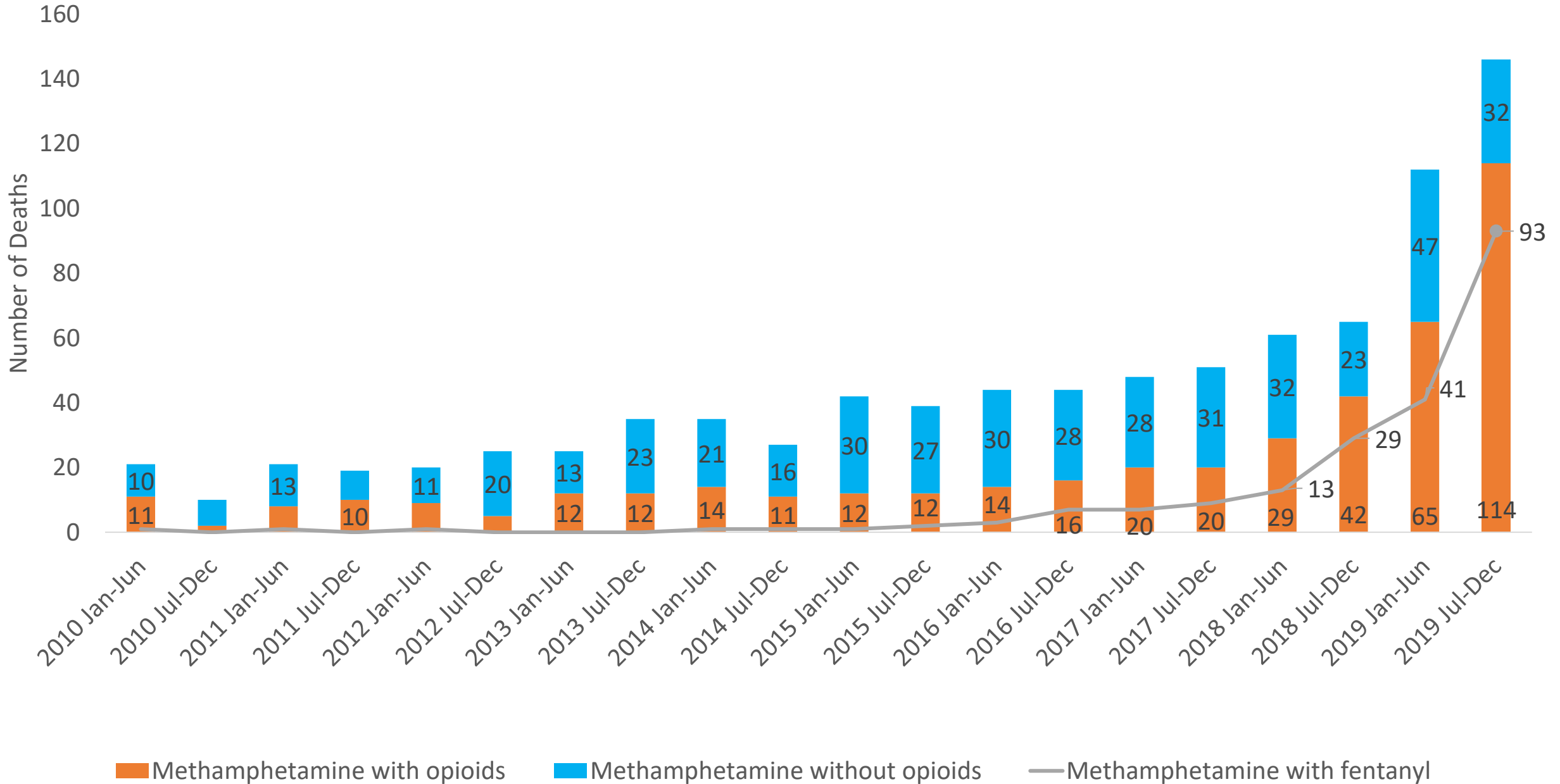


# Rate per 100,000 Population of Opioid Overdose Deaths by Race/Ethnicity in San Francisco, 2006-2019

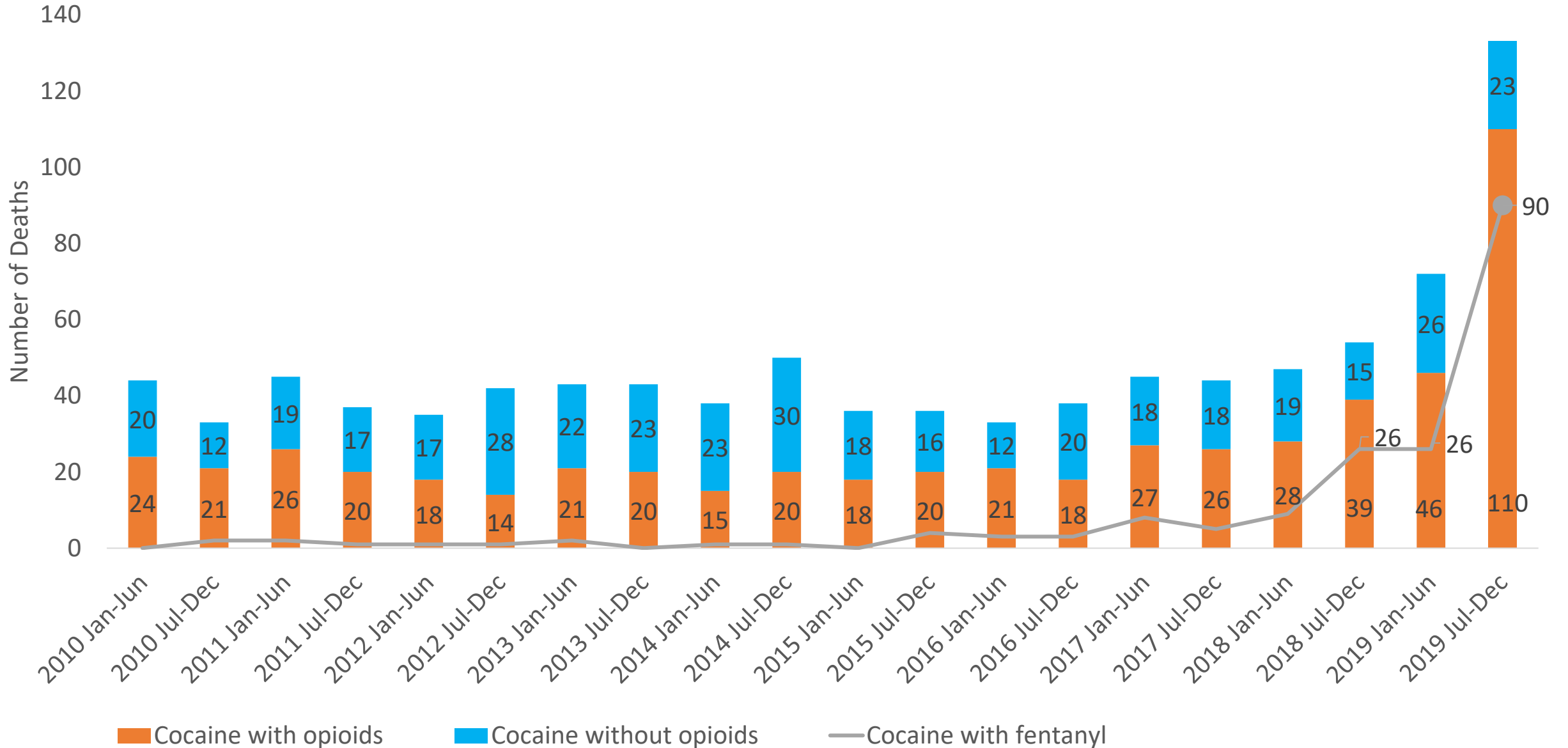




# Number of Methamphetamine Overdose Deaths by Opioid Involvement and Half-Year in San Francisco, 2010-2019

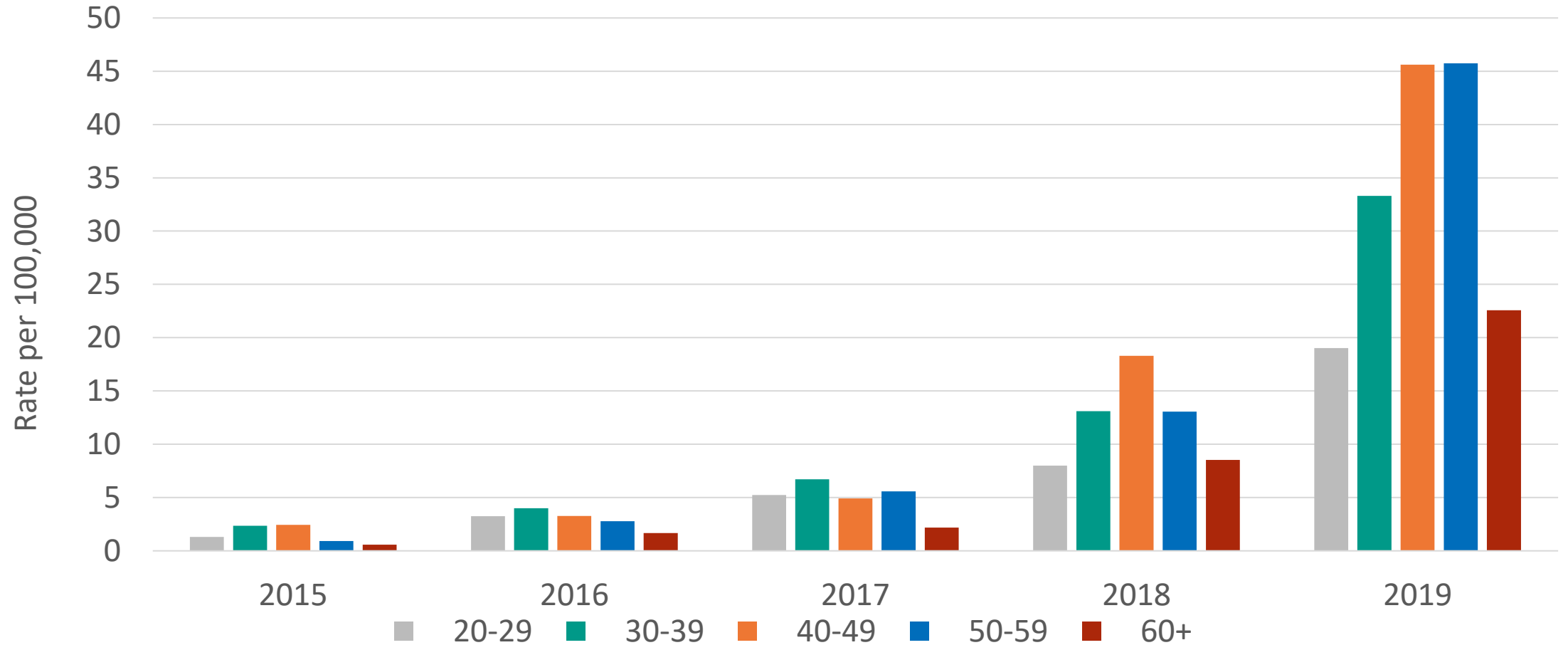


# Number of Cocaine Overdose Deaths by Opioid Involvement and Half-Year in San Francisco, 2010-2019

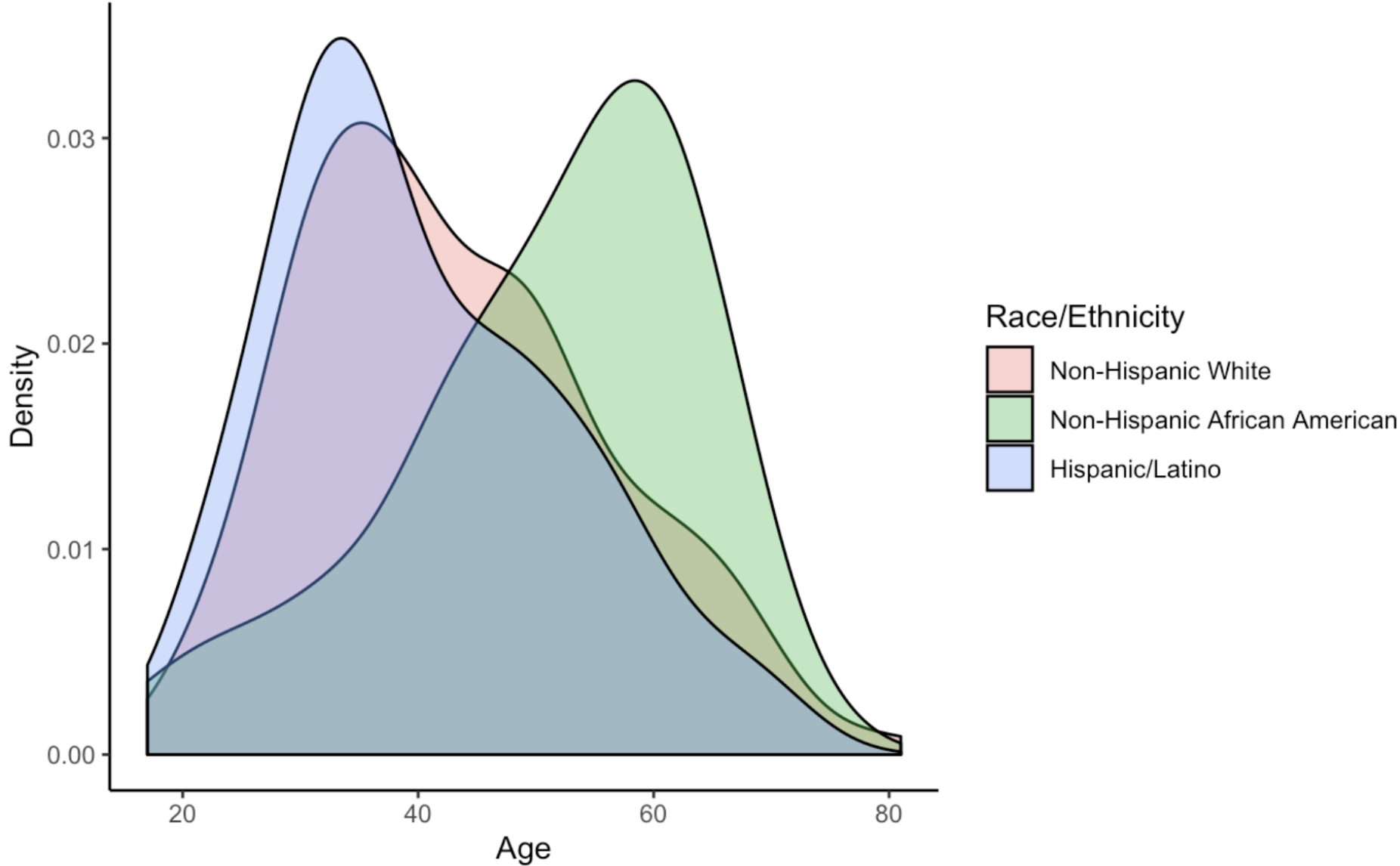




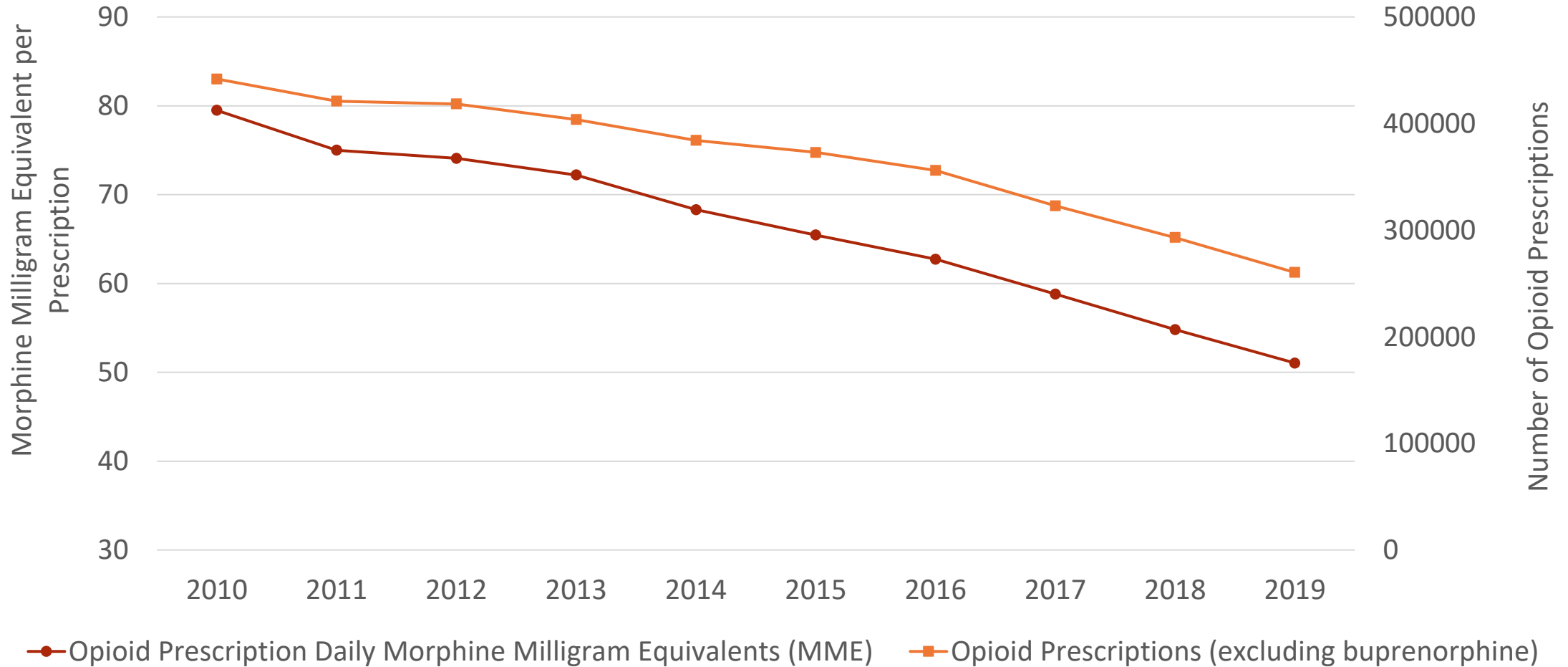
# Rate of Fentanyl Overdose Deaths by Age Category in CCSF, 2015–2019



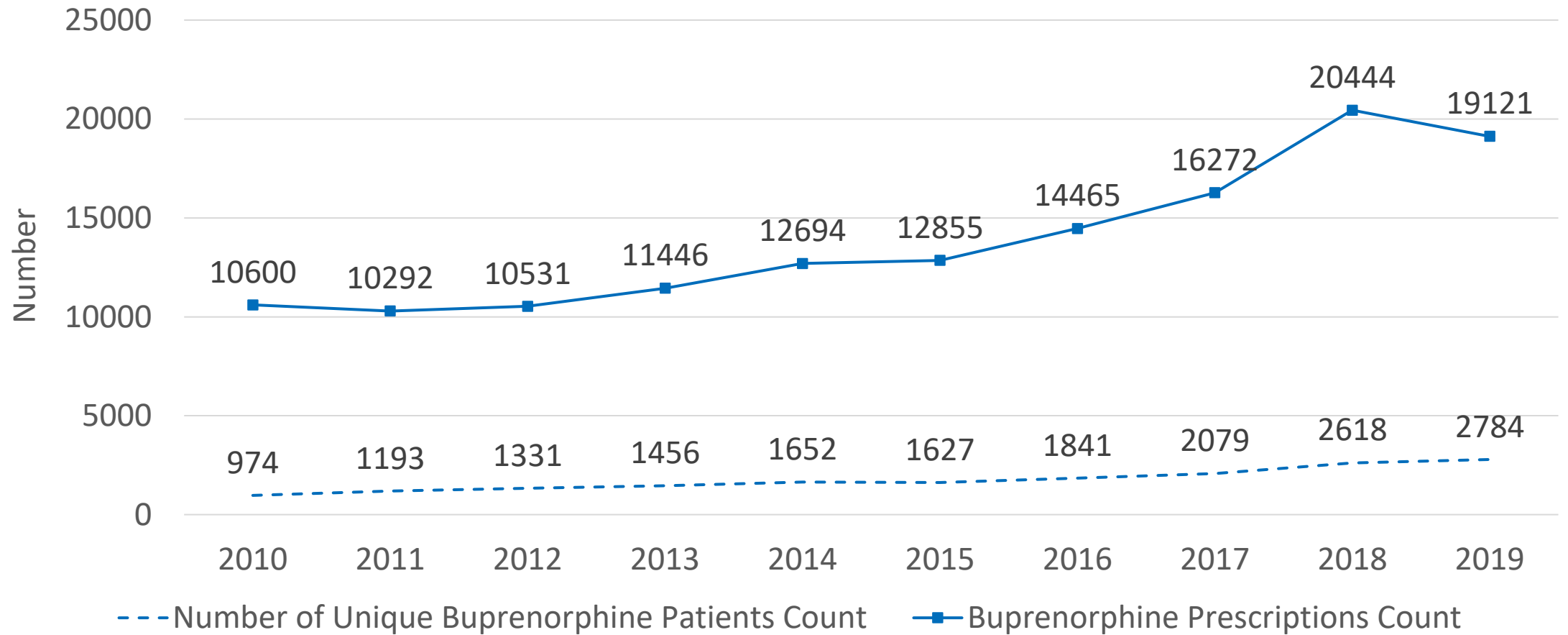
# Age Distribution of Fentanyl Overdose Deaths by Race/Ethnicity San Francisco, 2018-2019



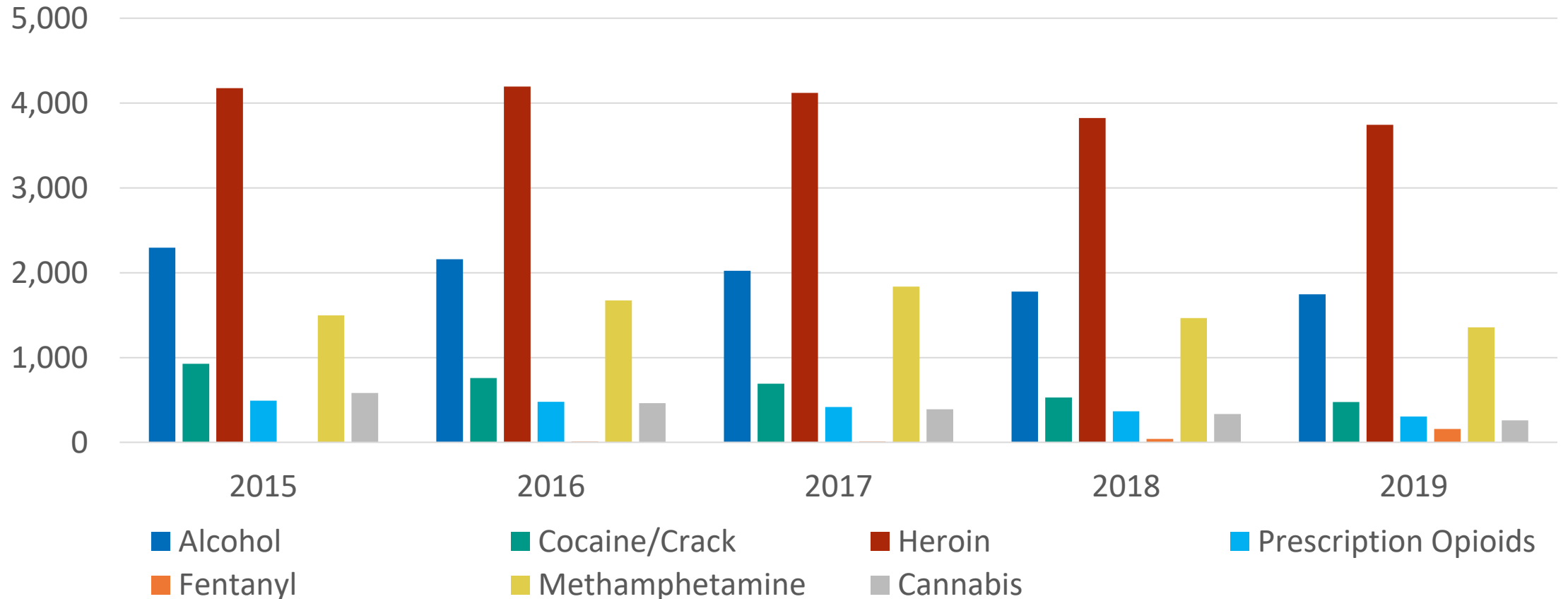
# Number of Opioid Prescriptions and Daily MMEs per Opioid Prescription in CCSF, 2010–2019



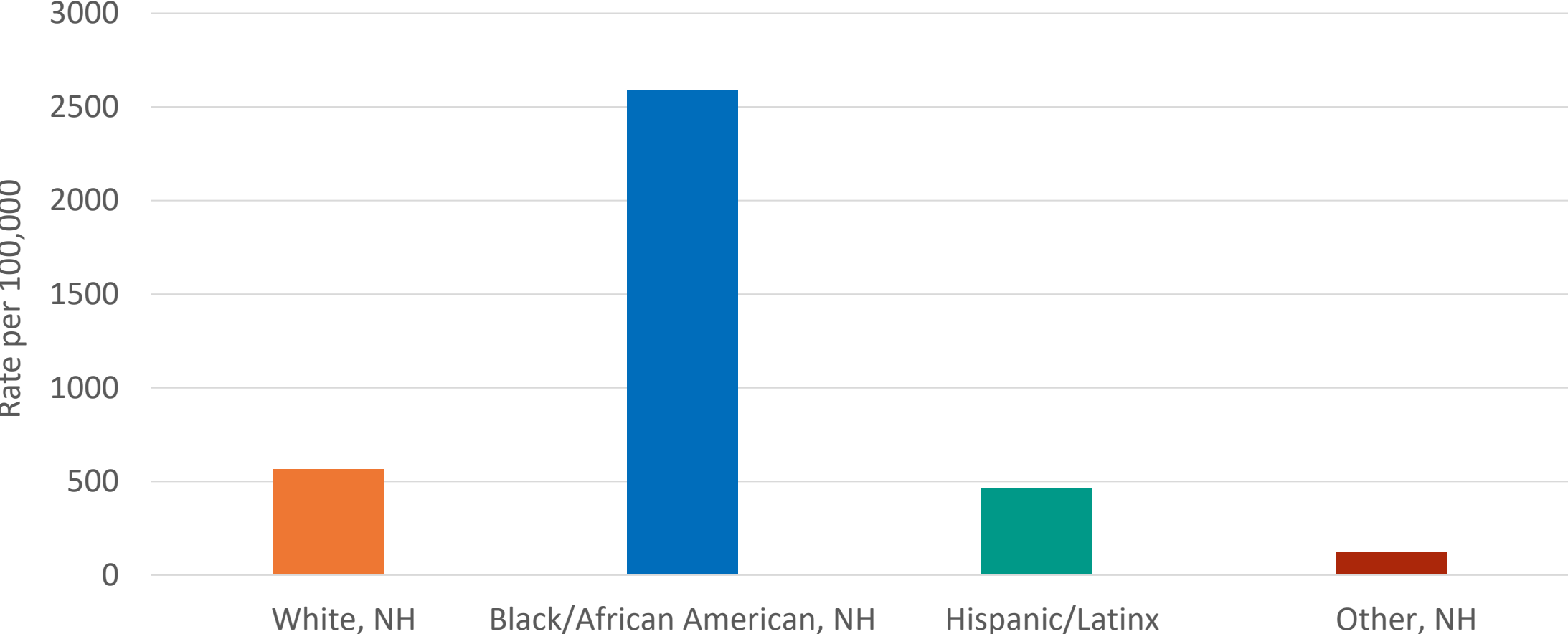
# Annual Number of Buprenorphine Prescriptions and Number of Unique Patients Receiving Buprenorphine Prescriptions in CCSF, 2010–2019



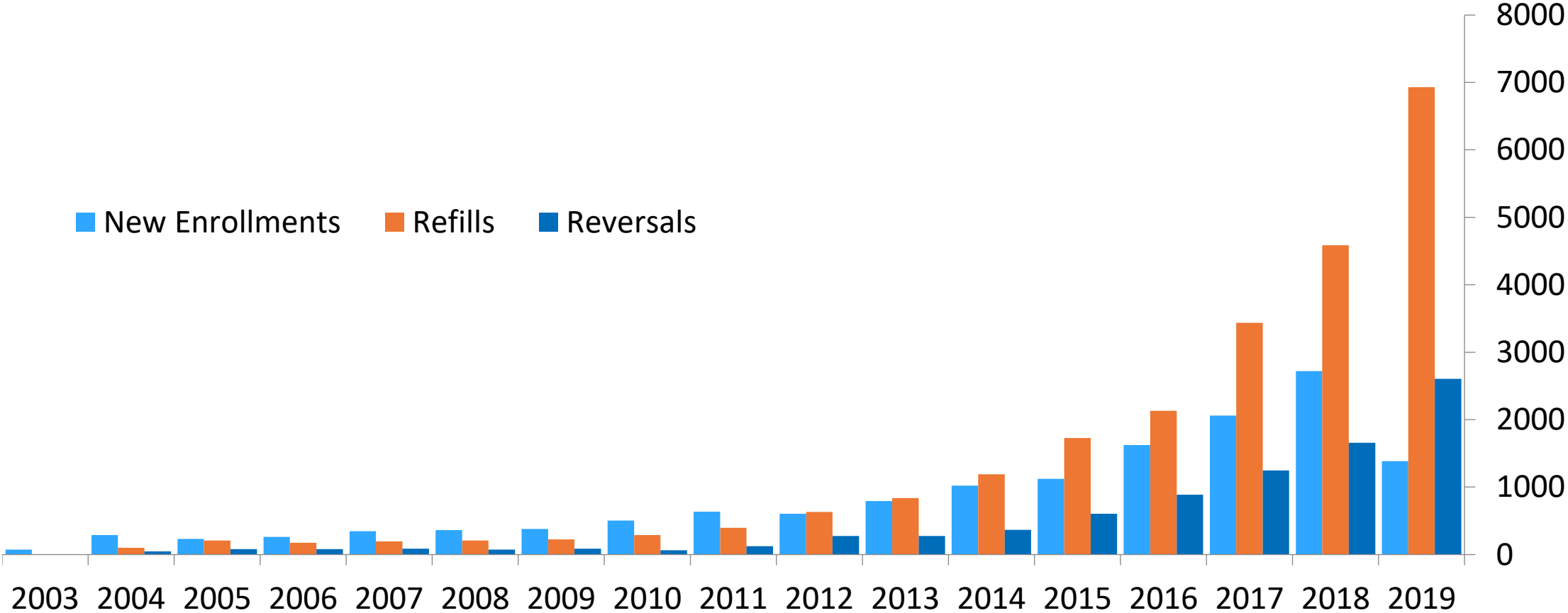
# Number of Admissions to Programs Treating Substance Use Disorders by Primary Substance in San Francisco, 2015–2019



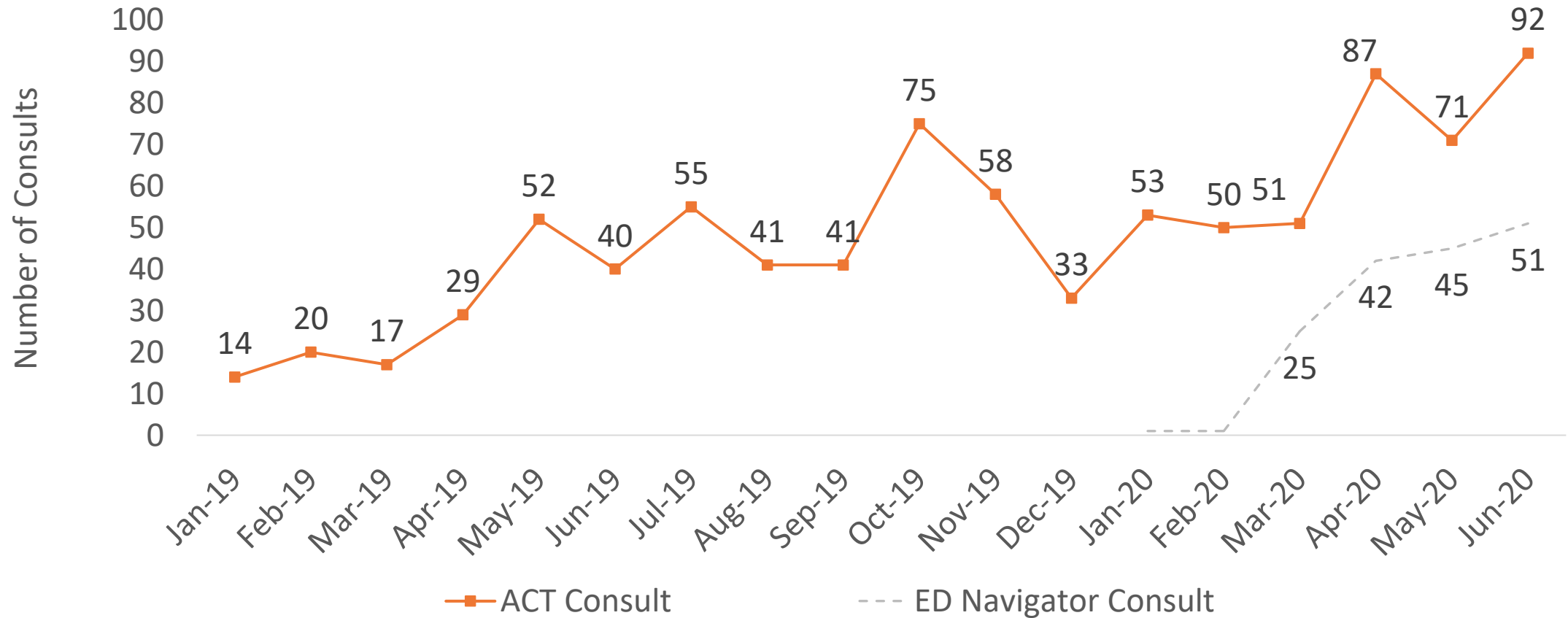
# Rate of Admissions to Programs Treating Substance Use Disorders for Any Opioids by Race/Ethnicity in CCSF, 2019

# Conclusions

- Overdose deaths due to opioids and stimulants are rising rapidly, driven by fentanyl; no localities have successfully managed the introduction of fentanyl without large increases in overdose mortality
- The rate per population of drug overdose death is several times higher among Black/African American compared to White residents.
- Increased OUD treatment outside of SUD treatment programs more than makes up for declining admissions.
- Interventions continue to progress, including naloxone distribution and the Addiction Consult Team at ZSFGH
- Other interventions, such as the sobering center for drugs and safe consumption sites, have been on hold due to COVID-19 and related issues.
