The CICT program's mission is to provide culturally competent client centered care for San Franciscans who have tested positive for the coronavirus and their known contacts who may have been exposed. The goal of the Outbreak Management Group (OMG) is to prevent and manage outbreaks of COVID 19. Heluna Health will provide Fiscal Management and Staff Management through this contract, reimbursed at a 12.8 percent indirect rate, earning up to \$788,480 with the balance of \$5,371,520 for CICT and Outbreak Management staff salaries. The contract will be monitored in accordance with all applicable Departmental procedures through the DPH Business Office, Office of Contract Compliance (BOCC). Specifically Fiscal and Compliance Monitoring of Heluna Health's fiscal and human resources administration functions will be conducted.

Nondiscrimination and Cultural Competency:

The Contractor will participate in applicable cultural competency requirements.

Other Significant Issues:

The primary purpose of this contract is to provide fiscal and human resources services, specifically related to and including the hiring and management of employees to serve on the City's Contact Tracing and Case Investigation (CICT) team or in the Outbreak Management Group.

The CICT team is a multidisciplinary team that focuses on ensuring both the identified COVID+ individual "case" and exposed contacts are connected to support services, including testing, isolation and quarantine housing and food assistance. The CICT Program is a collaboration with the Epidemiology and Surveillance Branch of the SFDPH and interfaces with the Outbreak Management Group of the City's COVID Incident Command System to prevent and follow-up to outbreaks of COVID-19.

As a result of the pandemic, and the continued cases in San Francisco, data has strongly indicated the need for Contact Tracing and Case Investigation services specialists who will engage in the investigation of COVID in the City and County of San Francisco to reduce the impact and rates of infection.

PHFE dba Heluna Health (Heluna) has been a valued partner in supporting as-needed special projects for the Department for more than twenty years.

The proposed contract is authorized under RFQ 3-2020 DPH As Needed Project Based Program Administration and Support Services.
