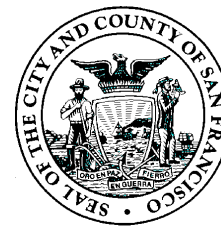

1) CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order at 2:38pm.

2) APPROVAL OF JANUARY 21, 2020 COMMUNITY AND PUBLIC HEALTH COMMITTEE MINUTES

Action Taken: The Committee unanimously approved the January 21, 2020 minutes.

3) HOUSING CONSERVATORSHIP UPDATE

Angelica Almeida, Ph.D, Director, Forensic/Justice Behavioral Health Services, presented the item.

Commissioner Comments:

Commissioner Chung asked for more information regarding housing options for conserved individuals. Dr. Almeida stated that the program works with a range of providers, including the Department of Homelessness and Supportive Housing, to ensure a wide range of wrap-around services are available to this population.

Commissioner Bernal asked if program forms are provided in multiple languages. Dr. Almeida confirmed that program forms are provided in multiple languages.

Commissioner Bernal asked if there is prioritized housing for this cohort. Dr. Almeida stated that program target population is already on the priority list for housing. The program works closely with the Department of Homelessness and Supportive Housing on housing options for clients.

4) SAN FRANCISCO METHAMPHETAMINE TASK FORCE OVERVIEW AND UPDATES

Patrick Chang, Office of Policy and Planning, and Dr. David Pating, MD, San Francisco Health Network Addiction Psychiatric Substance Use Services, presented the item.

Commissioner Comments:

Commissioner Giraud noted that in her experience as a psychologist working with children and youth, there is an increase in drug use among this population. She requested a list of resources in schools. Dr. Pating stated that he would send resources through Mr. Morewitz.

Commissioner Chung asked if the Taskforce is still active. Mr. Chang stated that the Taskforce has ended and its recommendations will be implemented through the DPH and other CCSF Departments.
