### **Explanation of Service Change and Variances:**

This is a new contract for an application originally procured as a subcontract with Siemens Medical Solutions, USA.

Surgical Information Systems (SIS) is the electronic clinical documentation system for the perioperative unit at Zuckerberg San Francisco General Hospital (ZSFG). The Peri-operative Unit includes the pre-operative clinic, pre-operative surgery, anesthesia, and post-operative documentation. It is also a significant revenue source for DPH.

### Nondiscrimination and Cultural Competency:

The Contractor will participate in applicable cultural competency requirements for the upcoming year.

#### **Sole Source:**

The implementation, licensing and maintenance of this system is an authorized sole source under Administrative Code 21.3. SIS was originally procured via the contract with Siemens Medical, our current EHR contractor. After Siemens was acquired by Cerner, the existing business relationship between the two companies dissolved. The City must engage SIS to license and maintain the current system to protect patient care during the larger EHR procurement process.

## Other Significant Issues:

Surgical Information Systems is based in Alpharetta Georgia, with 213 employees and has been in business for more than 20 years.

# Listing of Board of Directors, Owners of 10% or More of the Firm, and Executive Director:

Surgical Information Systems, LLC is 100% owned by SIS Merger Co., which is 100% owned by SIS Holding Corp. Owners of 10% or more of SIS Holding Corp. are: Norwest Equity Partners IX, LP and Norwest Equity Partners VIII, LP. The members of the board of directors of SIS Holding Corp. are:
