Explanation of Service Change and Variances:

This is a new contract.

Monitoring Report/Program Review & Follow-up:

The contract services will be monitored by the Department as required. The SFDPH Program Administrator will be responsible for assisting and tracking all information related to the accomplishment of the project.

Nondiscrimination and Cultural Competency:

The Department will work closely with the contractor to ensure that their cultural competency plan is current and in compliance with Departmental procedures.

Other Significant Issues:

Nordic Consulting Partners, Inc. (Nordic) was selected as a qualified proposer under RFQ-38-2016 Category 1, Project 2 (CAT1-P2-38-2016). By RFP CAT1-P2-38-2016, Nordic was selected for a task based contract to aid DPH with project/coordination needs for operational readiness before and throughout the (EHR) implementation. Project tasks may include: (1) EHR Communication Planning and Support, (2) EHR Human Resource Planning and Implementation, (3) EHR Implementation and Readiness for Security and Role Based Access, (4) EHR Integration of core organization functions with unified vision, (5) governance and operating model, EHR and DPH related Organizational Change Management, (6) EHR related IT Infrastructure Governance (IG)/Analytics Infrastructure, (7) EHR related IT backfill, and (8) and Rhapsody Interface Development. Dependent upon whether or not Nordic will bid on the individual Tasks assigned from this RFP, Nordic may or may not be awarded a Tasks within this RFP.

Nordic's has a combination of program and project management expertise and deep knowledge of Epic's methodology. Nordic's consultants have worked with more than 90% of Epic customers. Nordic understands the implementation of Epic within the context of the State of California requires additional care and billing regulations and initiatives, such as Medi-Cal, unions, behavioral health, PRIME, and the Whole Person Care Initiative, which can present unique challenges to an Epic Implementation. Nordic has experience working with other major county health systems in the Bay Area, including Contra Costa Health Services and Santa Clara Valley Health and Hospital System.
