The Contractor will participate in applicable cultural competency requirements for the upcoming year.

Other Significant Issues:

Through a partnership with the University of California at San Francisco (UCSF), Medweb has been servicing Zuckerberg San Francisco General (ZSFG) and San Francisco Health Network (SFHN) Community Oriented Primary Care (COPC) clinics for Teledermatology for over four years.

The initial acquisition of the software was through UCSF under a State of California grant. The equipment purchased using these grant funds administered by UCSF has now transitioned to the Department to maintain and keep active.

This new license agreement between Medweb and DPH will allow Telehealth to continue providing and improving services throughout 12 COPC clinics in Teledermatology, and to expand services to the Jail Health system.

In addition to Teledermatology, this software license agreement will enable Telehealth to provide TeleWound Care through an implementation project that will be phased in over the term of the contract.

These Telehealth applications enable primary care providers at COPC clinics to communicate with specialists and receive diagnoses and treatment recommendations for their patients through the Medweb secure vendor-supported platform.

Medweb solutions are installed in over 1,000 worldwide. Medweb is a San Francisco based company, with 78 employees, and has been in business for more than 20 years.
