Explanation of Service:

The primary objective of this contract is to provide Peer Navigators in order to assist transgender and gender non-conforming youth (ages 12-24) in San Francisco navigate health care options.

Transgender and gender non-conforming youth encounter multiple barriers to accessing and navigating health care and behavioral health services. These obstacles include: lack of safe/welcoming environments, a space to explore healthcare options, providers who lack knowledge of services or gender affirming health care (i.e. competency), insurance coverage status which excludes needed services, inadequate resources to address mental health concerns, and a lack of continuity and support from the community. Due to all of these factors, youth need knowledgeable, skilled, and trustworthy allies who can guide them as they navigate the health care system. Within DPH, Peer Navigation services have shown positive results in advancing personal wellness goals and increasing patient satisfaction with health care outcomes and these youth could greatly benefit from this resource.

Main Functions of the two Peer Navigator positions funded through this contract:

- Peer Navigator(s) act as a coach, working with youth to help them define, achieve and maintain individualized goals
- Community engagement and education about Peer Navigator services
- Engagement activates to connect youth to Peer Navigator(s)
- Navigators assist and guide youth with (including but not limited to):
 - o Make/Accompanying youth to medical appointments
 - o Helping youth communicate with medical/behavioral health professionals, as needed
 - O Assisting with follow-up as necessary (lab, tests, prescriptions)
 - o Helping with other supports as necessary
- Assistance and support with and thru gender affirming surgery

Monitoring Report/Program Review & Follow-Up:

The contract services will be monitored by the Department as required.

The SFDPH Program Administrator will be responsible for assessing and tracking all information related to the accomplishment of the project.

Nondiscrimination and Cultural Competency:

The Department will work closely with the contractor to ensure that their cultural competency plan is current and in compliance with Departmental procedures.
