RESOLUTION NO. 018-85

RESOLUTION URGING THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS AND THE MAYOR TO SUBMIT A CHARTER AMENDMENT REGARDING EMPLOYEES OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF MENTAL HEALTH TO THE VOTERS OF SAN FRANCISCO ON NOVEMBER 5, 1985.

WHEREAS, Assembly Bill 3921 (chaptered September 25, 1984) requires the transfer of state employees of the San Francisco field unit of the State of California Department of Mental Health, Office of Mental Health Social Services to City and County employment; and

WHEREAS, this transfer shall be at no additional cost to the City and County; and

WHEREAS, City and County staff have completed a plan acceptable to the State of California Department of Mental Health to transfer said employees to the Department of Public Health of the City and County of San Francisco, at no additional cost to the City and County; therefore be it

RESOLVED, that the San Francisco Health Commission urges the Board of Supervisors and Her Honor, the Mayor, to submit a Charter amendment on this issue to the voters of the City and County of San Francisco at an election to be held therein on November 5, 1985.
