RESOLUTION NO. 027-85

RESOLUTION PROHIBITING THE SALES OF TOBACCO PRODUCTS ON DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH PREMISES.

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Health with its constituent agencies including the San Francisco General Hospital and the Laguna Honda Hospital has as its dominant mission the protection of the health of the residents of San Francisco; and

WHEREAS, the injurious nature of tobacco products is well-known and documented; and

WHEREAS, the United States Public Health Service and all leading health authorities consider termination of tobacco use as the single most important measure for health maintenance and disease prevention; and

WHEREAS, it would be manifestly inconsistent for a department devoted to health to engage in the sale and distribution of tobacco products through any of its facilities; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That tobacco products will not be sold on the premises of any Department of Public Health facility, effective September 1, 1985.
