RESOLUTION NO. 029-85

RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH TO SUBMIT RESOLUTIONS TO APPLY FOR, ACCEPT AND EXPEND GRANT FUNDS FOR THE CALENDAR OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS AT THE SAME TIME THAT THOSE RESOLUTIONS ARE CALENDARED FOR REVIEW BY THE HEALTH COMMISSION.

WHEREAS, San Francisco Administrative Code Section 10.170 provides, in part, that no application for a federal, state or other grant involving any project or program shall be filed or authorized by any Commission unless first recommended by the Mayor and approved by the Board of Supervisors; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Health submits resolutions to apply for, accept and expend grant funds for review by the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco after said resolutions have been reviewed and approved by the Health Commission; and

WHEREAS, the sequential nature of this submittal process precludes review and approval by the Board of Supervisors of resolutions to apply for these grant funds prior to the actual date of application for these funds; and


WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors' approval to apply for grant funds after the actual date of application constitutes a violation of Administrative Code Section 10.170; now therefore be it

RESOLVED, that on signature by the President of the Health Commission or, in the alternative, the Chairman of the Committee on Budget and Management of the Health Commission, resolutions to apply for, accept and expend grant funds may be submitted to the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors to be calendared for Board review at the same time that those resolutions are calendared for review by the Health Commission; now therefore be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that right of first review by the Health Commission of said grant resolutions is recognized and affirmed; and that actual review of said grant resolutions will be held by the Health Commission prior to the review of these resolutions by the Board of Supervisors; now therefore be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that this right of first review will be honored by removing any grant resolution not already fully reviewed and approved by the Health Commission from the calendar of the Health Committee of the Board of Supervisors, prior to its review.
