RESOLUTION NO. 035-85

RESOLUTION INVITING THE COMMISSIONERS FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL SERVICES AND THE COMMISSION ON AGING TO FORM A WORKING GROUP FOR POLICY COORDINATION

WHEREAS, The Department of Public Health, the Department of Social Services, and the Commission on Aging all provide services to those in need of long term health care; and

WHEREAS, Some of these services are provided to mutual clients; and

WHEREAS, The Health Commission recognizes that a need exists for a collaborative effort with members of the Department of Social Services Commission and Commission on Aging in order to develop a clear set of policies for providing services to those in need of long term health care, particularly in the areas of adult daycare and support services; and

WHEREAS, Improvement of working relationships among interdepartmental agencies would benefit delivery of services to those in need of long term health care and others; now therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the Health Commission invites the Department of Social Services Commission and the Commission on Aging to join the Health Commission in creating group for policy coordination to consider policy issues relating to the provision of services to those in need of long term health care; and therefore be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Health Commission invites the Commission on Aging and the Department of Social Services to form an interdepartmental program working group of Health Department, Commission on Aging, and Department of Social Services staff to identify program duplication and need for additional programs, and to make recommendations to the policy body which would eliminate this duplication, make the existing levels of service more effective, and increase existing services.
