
RESOLUTION DECLARING A POLICY TO CONTRACT FOR NEW HEALTH SERVICES BY USING COMPETITIVE SELECTION PROCEDURES.

WHEREAS, Competitive bid selection procedures have been shown to encourage competition, reduce costs, and provide minority and women owned businesses with opportunities to contract with the City and County; and

WHEREAS, In some instances, sole source selection procedures are indicated because of time constraints, uniqueness of a contractor or when only one proposal is received to a request; now be it

RESOLVED, That Health Commission supports competitive selection procedures when using contractors to provide new health services for the Department of Public Health and authorizes the department to use sole source selection only when competitive bidding is not an appropriate means of selection.
