RESOLUTION NO. 56-85

RESOLUTION APPROVING FEES FOR CERTIFICATION AND RE-CERTIFICATION OF
PRE-HOSPITAL PERSONNEL

Whereas, The nine Bay Area Counties provide State mandated testing and certification of pre-hospital personnel including paramedics, emergency medical technicians, and authorized registered nurses; and

Whereas, Most of the other counties charge fees to recover the costs of certification and re-certification of such personnel; and

Whereas, The City and County of San Francisco Emergency Services Agency does not charge fees to recover the costs of these services; and

Whereas, The Department of Health staff have analyzed the costs of testing and certification and have recommended a fee schedule which would recover the costs; and

Whereas, The proposed fee schedule could be waived for the authorized registered nurses by the Director of Health should the Director determine that a waiver of such fees would benefit the City and County; now therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the Health Commission approves the proposed fees schedule for certification and re-certification of pre-hospital personnel and authorizes the Emergency Medical Services Agency to institute such fees effective February 1, 1986.
