RESOLUTION OF THE HEALTH COMMISSION DECLARING THE NEED TO EXPEDITE THE EXPANSION AND RENOVATIONS OF THE PSYCHIATRIC EMERGENCY ROOM AS AN EMERGENCY.

Whereas, the Health Commission is the governing body of the Department of Health and has approved funding requests for the renovation and expansion of the department's psychiatric emergency facility located at San Francisco General Hospital; and

Whereas, the number of patients seen daily at the psychiatric emergency facility has increased over the past several years, and the size of the space is no longer large enough to accommodate the patients;

Whereas, in order to meet licensing and accreditation requirements, the psychiatric emergency services space must be enlarged; and

Whereas, the Department of Public Works cannot begin the renovations immediately unless the City declares this project as an emergency; therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the Health Commission declares the need for renovations at the psychiatric emergency services facility as an emergency, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the Health Commission urges the Board of Supervisors to declare the renovations of this space as an emergency.
