RESOLUTION NO. 067-86

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE SUBMISSION OF JOINT APPLICATIONS WITH THE COMMISSION ON AGING AND THE DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL SERVICES FOR PROJECTS FOR THE ELDERLY AND SUPPORTING COLLABORATION OF THE STAFF OF THE THREE AGENCIES.

Whereas, the Health Commission and Department of Health staff participate in a Joint Commission with representatives of the Social Services Commission and the Commission on Aging to improve services to those in need of long term care; and

Whereas, one of the objectives of the Joint Commission is to improve services through collaboration and coordination of the three agencies; and

Whereas, the Joint Commission has recommended that the three agencies submit joint responses for three service and funding opportunities including Project Seed, a pilot project from the State Department on Aging for technical assistance to improve integration of services to the elderly, a grant from the National Institute for Aging for identifying the needs of the elderly in minority groups, and a Robert Wood Johnson Foundation grant to provide support services to the elderly; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the Health Commission approves the submission of joint response to the three projects, and be it further

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the Health Commission authorizes staff from the Department of Health to continue to coordinate and collaborate their efforts with the staff of the Department of Social Services and the Commission on Aging in the area of long term care.
