**RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF AMENDING CHAPTER 15 OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE CODE BY
ADDING SECTION 15.7-1 THERETO, STATING STANDARDS FOR MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES**

WHEREAS, the Joint Conference Committee on Mental Health and Senior Staff of the Division of Mental Health Services in the Department of Public Health have reviewed the proposed mental health policy legislation; and


WHEREAS, the Health Commission sees that the Division of Mental Health Services is moving in the right direction to reduce reliance on acute hospital care through the development of a comprehensive range of noninstitutional community services; and,

WHEREAS, the Health Commission and the Department of Public Health support a City policy serving as a guideline for planning of mental health services; therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Health Commission approves the intent of the mental health policy legislation to serve as a guiding direction for mental health services in San Francisco; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Health Commission submit this resolution to the Human Services Committee of the Board of Supervisors.
