RESOLUTION NO. 090-87

RESOLUTION APPOINTING MENTAL HEALTH CONSERVATORSHIP FOR THE CITY AND COUNTY OF SAN FRANCISCO

Whereas, individuals who are gravely disabled as a result of a mental disorder or impairment by chronic alcoholism require a Conservator; and

Whereas, the Welfare & Institutions Code Section 5350-5371 sets forth a procedure for establishing, administering and terminating conservatorship; and

Whereas, the Welfare & Institutions Code 5355 refers to the County designating an employee to serve as Conservator for individuals determined by the Court to be gravely disabled, and


Whereas, the State Department of Mental Health has stated it is no longer appropriate for its Office of Mental Health Social Services to serve as the County's Conservator, and

Whereas, it is important to ensure that the conservatorship function and the treatment function be well coordinated on behalf of the Conservatee,

Therefore, be it resolved that the Director of Health is hereby designated the Conservator for the City and County of San Francisco.

Be it further resolved that the Director of Health is to select someone sufficiently independent from the Director of Mental Health.
