RESOLUTION NO. 098-87

RESOLUTION TO AMEND ADMINISTRATIVE CODE DELETING SECTION
THAT REQUIRES MENTAL HEALTH AND SUBSTANCE ABUSE CONTRACTS BE
REVIEWED AND APPROVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

Whereas, the Department of Public Health will provide the Board of Supervisors with an annual plan for mental health and substance abuse services; and

Whereas, the Department of Public Health will prepare a report for the Board of Supervisors which will identify the funding allocation for services and information on the contractors providing the service, consistent to the information in the budget which is reviewed and approved by the Board of Supervisors; and

Whereas, the approval process of the Health Commission, in reviewing each proposed contract and proposed modification, includes a study of the performance evaluation, analysis of funding and unit cost, receipt of a financial audit, a review of affirmative action policies and performance of the programs, and the appropriateness of services; and


Whereas, the approval of each contract or modification is contingent on the contractors' satisfactory performance with these criteria; and

Whereas, through the Department the Health Commission will provide the Board of Supervisors with quarterly information on the contract approval process; therefore

Be it resolved, that the Health Commission supports an amendment to Section 15.6 of the Administrative Code which would delete the requirement that mental health and substance abuse contracts be approved individually by the Board of Supervisors; and

Be it further resolved, that the Health Commission urge the Board of Supervisors to approve this amendment to the Code relating to mental health and substance abuse contracts.
